Viewer calls were accepted during the program.

Guests included Larry Robb, Posey County Emergency Management, Emily Zander, Red Cross, Sherman Greer, Vanderburgh Co. Emergency Management, and Ron Rhodes, WTVW Meteorologist.

WNIN provided national programming on the DTV Change four times between April 1 and June 30 in addition to two community workshops. WNIN provides a community calendar on both TV and the web page.
