Each week difference Senators and Legislators, both Democrats and Republicans would education viewers on State House news.
State of the City	Newsmakers	1/7/11	10:30pm	30 Minutes	This episode featured Evansville Mayor Jonathan Weinzapfel discussing the State of the City, the new arena, and bringing jobs to Evansville.
Local History	LST-325: History on the Riverfront	1/12/11	10:30pm	30 Minutes	This locally produced documentary focused on the LST-325 docked in Evansville, and now open as a museum. The program highlighted the history Evansville has in the manufacture of the LSTs.
Local Culture	Frog Follies	2/15/11	10:30pm	30 Minutes	This locally-produced documentary featured the many colorful participants in Evansville's annual Frog Follies Festival, as they described their autos, and the great time they have visiting Evansville each year.
Local Culture	Mesker Park Zoo and Botanical Gardens	3/15/11	1:30pm	30 Minutes	This locally-produced documentary took viewers on a field trip through the Mesker Park Zoo and Botanical Gardens. Included in the special was a look at the new Amazonia exhibit.
