The Art of Promoting Your Business on the Auction

Over 30 years ago, when Becky Magura reached out to Jackie Borden of Borden Jewelry for merchandise to be showcased in the very first WCTE Great TV Auction, Jackie was proud to be a part of it. Jackie has been involved with the Auction every year since, as a participating business and, on occasion, as an Auction solicitor.

This year when our new Auction Coordinator, Jodi Pitts, asked Jackie to participate in the Auction, as usual, he didn't hesitate. Jackie has generously donated gift certificates to the Auction for years. He was prepared to do it again. As Jodi looked around the store, she asked why he wasn't using the TV exposure to showcase some of his merchandise instead.

"She had a point," remarked Jackie. "The certificates we've been donating to the Auction are not really representing

the store all that well. This year we are donating items that showcase some of what we carry in the store – items that more effectively represent us. You'll be able to bid on Pandora Jewelry, Seiko watches and a porcelain sculpture from Borden Jewelry."

What Jackie and Jodi talked about that day ignited a chain reaction and it has inspired other businesses to be more thoughtful about what they want to showcase.

"Avid bidders from all over the Upper Cumberland and Middle Tennessee will be watching and bidding," commented Jodi. "We shoot TV spots for anything that comes in over \$1,000 and we absolutely love certificate donations – they sell well."

"Certificates can be a great promotion! However, depending on the type of

business, it may be more compelling to *not* leave it to the bidder's imagination. You really have to think about it. Will visual merchandise work better? The bidders might not win the item but maybe they are in the market for it. Who knows how many other viewers liked the item and were unaware your business carried it?"

"So you have to ask yourself - is the item you are donating truly showcasing your business? Are you making the most of your TV exposure?"

Volunteer Auction Coordinator

This will be Cookeville native Kelly Clarkson's second year as WCTE's Great TV Auction volunteer coordinator, a role she took on after transitioning from business owner to quality assurance coordinator at the Area Agency on Aging and Disability. She also works as the State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP) volunteer coordinator, which covers fourteen Upper Cumberland counties, so she's no stranger to the work required behind the scenes when organizing such a large task force.

An alumna of the University of Tennessee in Knoxville, Kelly has always gravitated toward volunteer work in her hometown. Beginning as a runner during WCTE's second year of auction, she has acted in almost every volunteer role ever since, including as a marker, a sorter, a board captain, a phone bank captain, a confirmation recorder, an over-the-phone bid taker, an information line worker, an auctioneer—and now volunteer coordinator!

A seemingly natural fit for such a reliable community member, Kelly's new role does have its challenges. "Sometimes it's difficult to get volunteers to commit early enough so I can accurately gauge how many more volunteers I'll need to recruit," she admits.

"Several of my 'regular' volunteers from last year have retired, so I'm always trying to find new people who want to be part of such an exciting, beloved event. It's easy once you get new volunteers there, though, because they absolutely love it! Then they always want to be put on the list for next year."

Between hosts, phone bank workers, runners, behind the board workers, warehouse staff, and confirmation recorders, Kelly estimates that around 100 volunteers are needed over the course of each night during the auction, which includes one shift change. It truly takes a community to make this event happen, and each volunteer makes a huge difference. "I've traveled all over the state and across the country," explains Kelly, "and I don't think everyone here realizes what a true gem we have in WCTE. We're so lucky for all the original programming, and this Great TV Auction is the station's biggest fundraiser of the year—which is why we need everyone's support!"



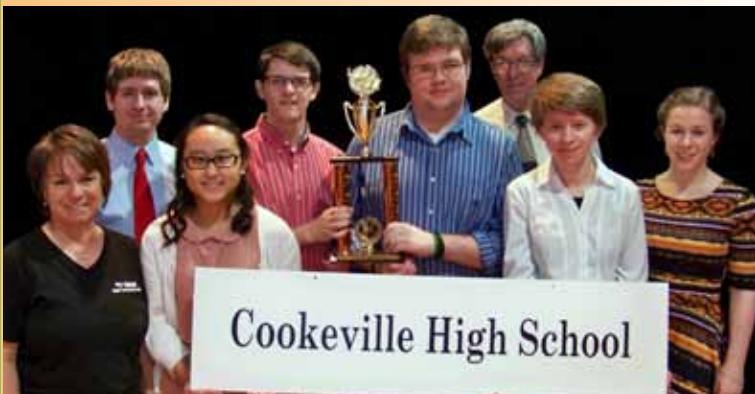
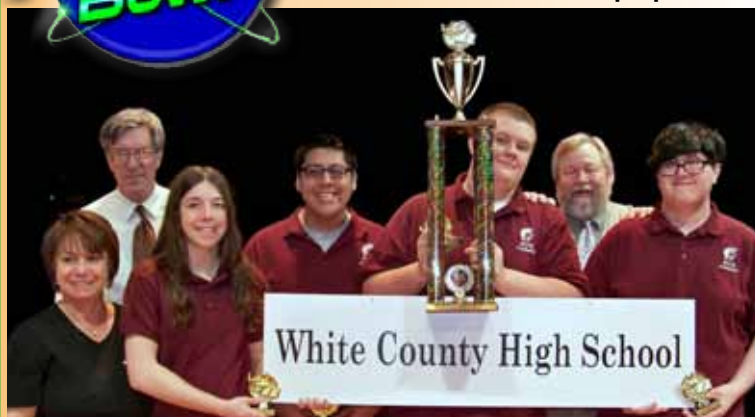

Yet even these remote places and creatures are at risk in today's world; being able to share their experiences with the rest of us is increasingly important to the Halls, and to us. Come along on the dive of a lifetime, to a tiny outpost 300 miles off the coast of Central America — Shark Mountain.

NOVA: Why Sharks Attack

In recent years, an unusual spate of deadly shark attacks has gripped Australia, resulting in five deaths in 10 months. At the same time, great white sharks have begun appearing in growing numbers off the beaches of Cape Cod, Massachusetts, not far from the waters where Steven Spielberg filmed Jaws. What's behind the mysterious arrival of this apex predator in an area where it's rarely been seen for hundreds of years? Are deadly encounters with tourists inevitable? To separate fact from fear, NOVA teams with leading shark experts in Australia and the United States to uncover the science behind the great white's hunting instincts. With shark populations plummeting, scientists race to unlock the secrets of these powerful creatures of the deep in their quest to save people and sharks.

In the second part of *United States of Secrets*, FRONTLINE explores the role of Silicon Valley in the National Security Agency's dragnet. As big technology companies encouraged users to share more and more information about their lives, they created a trove of data that could be useful not simply to advertisers, but also to the government. The revelations of NSA contractor Edward Snowden would push Silicon Valley into the center of a debate over privacy and government surveillance.

AMERICAN EXPERIENCE: Freedom Summer Tuesday, June 24, 8pm

*"I'm going down to Mississippi
I'm going down a Southern road
And if you never see me again
Remember that I had to go."*

During the summer of 1964, the nation's eyes were riveted on Mississippi. Over 10 memorable weeks known as Freedom Summer, more than 700 student volunteers joined with organizers and local African Americans in an historic effort to shatter the foundations of white supremacy in the nation's most segregated state. Working together, they canvassed for voter registration, created Freedom Schools, and established the Mississippi Freedom Democratic Party, with the goal of challenging the segregationist state Democratic Party at the national convention in Atlantic City. The campaign was marked by sustained and deadly violence, including the notorious murders of three civil rights workers, countless beatings, the burning of 35 churches and the bombing of 70 homes and Freedom Houses.

PERSONAL STORIES OF IRAQ AND AFGHANISTAN VETERANS AS THEY STRUGGLE TO REINTEGRATE INTO SOCIETY

Three Episodes Airing Tuesdays, May 13-27, 7pm-8pm

This new series recounts veteran and best-selling author, Wes Moore's search for answers to some of the most difficult questions related to returning from war. Moore's journey takes him into the personal lives of different soldiers as they attempt to reintegrate into society, establish new identities and – for many – find a new mission..

"We want to better humanize re-integration by taking the audience into the lives of these men and women as they return from war," said Moore, who is an Army combat veteran. "I want to make sure people understand these stories and who these people are who are coming back from combat."

The series begins with Moore's visit to Bonnie Collins, the mother of one of Moore's oldest friends and a fellow officer, Brian Collins. In

the first episode, "Coming Back," viewers learn that the previous year, after getting married and beginning a new career, Collins abruptly took his own life. This incident initiates Moore's desire to learn more about why some veterans can get on with their lives, while some cannot. In "Fitting In," Moore explores the concept of identity, how it's altered during deployment and how it's altered again when a veteran returns home. "Moving Forward," the final episode, examines the veterans' drive to find a new mission, to contribute, to be part of something bigger than themselves.

"**COMING BACK WITH WES MOORE** provides a window into the lives of those who have returned home after serving our country in a time of war," commented Beth Hoppe, Chief Programming Executive and General Manager of General Audience Programming at PBS. "PBS is proud to feature this

extraordinary series. It is a statement of thanks to the men and women who have served and continue to serve our nation. And it will contribute to an ongoing conversation about what we as a country — and as family, neighbors and friends — can do to help these soldiers return to civilian life."

"My hope is that the public can get a glimpse of what the end of the wars means to these brave men and women and to their families," continued Moore. "There is more we can do than simply saying 'thank you for your service.' We can truly show our gratitude by asking them to share their experiences."

Moore will travel to select cities and work with PBS member stations to speak to returning veterans, students and the general public. Local veterans groups in each community will further this conversation.
