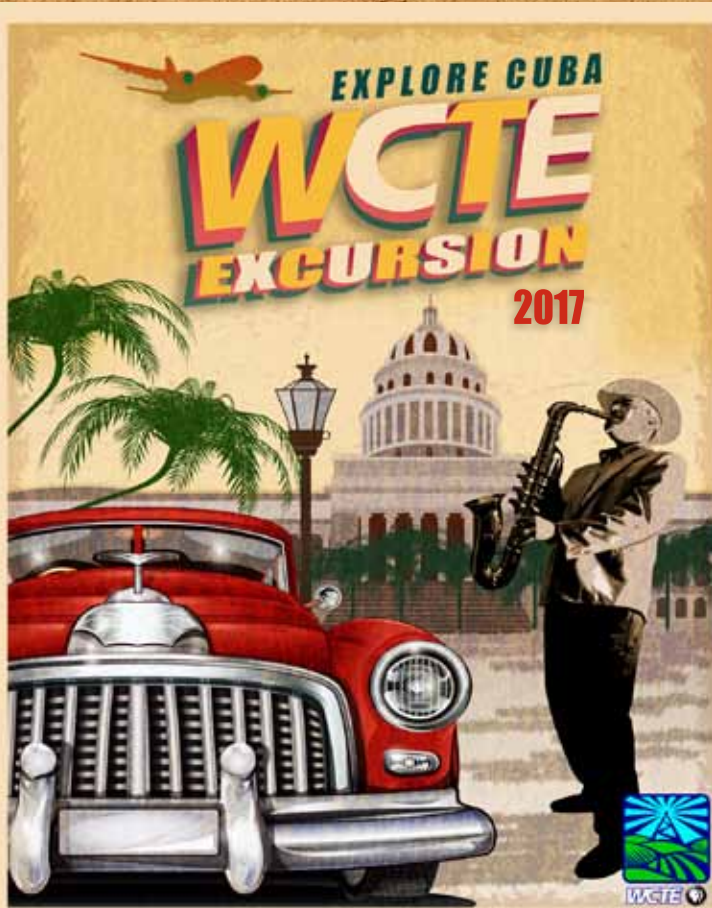

HAVANA TIME MACHINE

PREMIERES OCTOBER 6 at 8pm



Singer Raul Malo of The Mavericks explores his Cuban heritage in the breakthrough performance documentary *Havana Time Machine* on *Great Performances*. Eliades Ochoa, Ivette Cepeda, Roberto Fonseca, and the Sweet Lizzy Project join the versatile roots music star in an historical and musical journey through present-day Cuba.

"Like most Americans, Cuba seems like a dream, a land of rhythm and rum, of Ricky Ricardo and revolutionaries, baseball greats, gangsters, casinos, classic cars, and big cigars... But for me, it's the home I've never known, the place that my parents were formed, who in turn formed me. The roots of my musical soul have been reaching for Cuban soil my entire life. And now... the reality is beyond my wildest dream."

So remarks Grammy Award-winning singer-songwriter of The Mavericks and bandleader Raul Malo near the start of this pioneering music documentary, one of the first U.S. productions since travel restrictions have opened up in Cuba.

Born Raúl Francisco Martínez-Malo, Jr. to Cuban parents in Miami, the versatile roots-rock music singer embarks on a musical and historical odyssey through the present-day Cuban capital in *Havana Time Machine*, a US/Cuba collaborative musical showcase, on *Great Performances*.

Hermetically sealed by the Cold War for more than half a century Cuba remains, for the vast majority of Americans, the "Undiscovered Country," a unique time capsule of cultural traditions, relatively untouched. But the recent thawing of Cuban-U.S. relations is forging new relationships based on collaboration. The evolution of the Revolution creates a unique opportunity for a unique

public media presentation to showcase the tropical kaleidoscope that is Havana's musical scene, past, present, and future.

"So much in the world pulls people apart—politics, religion, even sports," commented producer Todd Jarrell. "But music has an almost unique power to bring people together, and in Cuba, art and music are at the center of their national identity."

Documented by richly atmospheric camera work, Malo visits such iconic locales as the grand boulevard, the Paseo del Prado; a small apartment/recording studio in Nuevo ado; the Instituto Superior de Arte (ISA); the former farm estate of Ernest Hemingway; and Los Jardines De La Tropical, a once-magical beer garden now overtaken by jungle. Along with way, Malo has musical encounters such luminaries as Eliades Ochoa, an original member of the famed Buena Vista Social Club; acclaimed Cuban singer Ivette Cepeda; Sweet Lizzy Project, a modern Latin indie-pop band; piano-jazz maestro Roberto Fonseca, and, of course, The Mavericks.

Havana Time Machine is produced by Todd Jarrell and Todd Mayo (producers of *Bluegrass Underground*), and directed and edited by Randy Hale and James Burton Yockey. Co-producer, Cuba, is Josue Lopez Lozano. *Havana Time Machine* is a production of Todd Squared, in association with THIRTEEN Productions LLC for WNET, Latino Public Broadcasting (LPB), and WCTE Upper Cumberland PBS.

Mid August: Here's Where Federal Funding Stands

Both chambers of Congress are currently out for their August recess. Thanks to your hard work, we were able to take several steps toward ensuring that public media is funded for generations to come before Congress departed.

However, there is still much work to do when Congress returns after Labor Day. Here is a quick overview of where federal funding for public media currently stands:

The Good News

The full House Appropriations Committee passed its Health and Human Services, Education and Related Agencies (Labor-HHS-Ed) FY 2018 spending bill, which includes full funding for the Corporation for Public Broadcasting (CPB) and Ready To Learn.

The Bad News

Unfortunately, the House did not include funding for Interconnection – which provides the essential infrastructure that allows your stations to broadcast your favorite programs – in its budget.

The Road Ahead

When Congress returns after Labor Day, our mission is to ensure that all public media funding, including funding for Interconnection, is included in the Senate spending bill and any final spending bill negotiated between the House and Senate.

What You Can Do

- Sign up to join the Protect My Public Media Action Network.
- Recruit your friends to join, too.
- Learn why federal funding is vital to the survival of your stations.

In the next few weeks, we'll share more information on the specific programs that support your stations' community services. All of these actions will help us protect public media funding when Congress returns.

We couldn't have made it this far without your help and look forward to continuing to work together to preserve public media.

CHANGING THE CONVERSATION

THE NATIONAL MILLENNIAL COMMUNITY

What characteristics make up a millennial? Some would say selfies, laziness, and entitlement. Spend a few minutes with a group of millennials and you will see that is far from the truth. The National Millennial Community (NMC) is a group founded by Bill Imada, Chairman and Chief Connectivity Officer of IW Group, Inc. and a National PBS Board member. NMC was created in 2015 with a goal to change the conversation about millennials. Community members from all across the country meet and have phone calls with top executives from various companies.

Mr. Imada chooses one university per state to select four student representatives from that university to participate in executive phone calls and to collaborate with other student reps across the country via Basecamp software. Another perk is that university reps get to travel to different cities to meet face to face with other reps from all across the country. Cities are chosen by Mr. Imada and the rest of the NMC team. During each visits, multiple companies are coordinated to participate during the 2-3 day excursions. I was selected at the beginning of this past spring to be one of Tennessee Tech's student reps. In June, I met with other community reps from Colorado to Delaware in Chicago, Illinois.

Over the course of three days, thirty NMC members worked hard to change the conversation with executives from companies such as McDonald's, Allstate Insurance, and NBC Universal/

NBC Media. Each company was given the opportunity to organize the time spent with the community as they saw fit. NBC decided that it would best to have an open discussion about topics chosen by executives from certain departments.

This particular meeting showed how diverse millennials actually are. It all started with a simple question, "What is the first thing you do in the morning?" Some answered Snapchat, Instagram, Facebook, or Twitter, while others answered email or reading/watching the news.

Millennials are supposed to be this "selfie obsessed" generation, but really millennials are inspiring companies to create ways for social media to go beyond the selfie. We are curious about current events and up-and-coming technology.

During the discussion with NBC, NMC members shared how we now use Snapchat for our morning news updates instead of turning on the TV and flipping to our favorite news channel.

It is such an honor to be part of this movement. I am learning and growing throughout my college experience, and this opportunity gives me a wider scope to prepare me to be the best professional and citizen that I can be. Millennials are changing the world and it's not because of the time we were born, it is the world we were born into. All we want to do is contribute and experience it all, while still making a difference. NMC is a great start and I can't wait to see what's next.

Keeping Up With The Latest Technology

A Company with Heart

To stay competitive and bring our viewers the quality they've come to expect, we need to keep up with the latest broadcast technology. At the same time, we are a non-profit PBS station with a very limited budget. When Jack McNulty, our account representative with Hitachi Kokusai Comark, heard we needed a new transmitter, the whole Comark team, including the President and CEO, Dick Fiore, became involved and worked with WCTE to provide one.

As Craig LeFevre, WCTE's Director of Technical Operations explained, the transmitter is responsible for amplifying our signal so that it can reach our viewers. The original signal we send the tower is low voltage. The transmitter boosts the power of the signal, "Exciters" convert it into a digital form that can be interpreted by your TV. By the time the signal hits the broadcast antenna, it is at a much higher power level. In addition to being sent to all of our viewers with antennas, that signal is picked up by cable companies, who in turn, send it to cable subscribers.

"Comark worked with the management of WCTE to provide a complete solution to replace their existing unit with the latest technology. The transmitter will be delivered with ATSC 1.0 compatible exciters, but the unit is easily upgradeable for ATSC 3.0 as soon as the station is ready for testing," said Dick Fiore, President and CEO of Hitachi Kokusai Electric Comark, LLC.

For those of you wondering, ATSC 3.0 is a signal that will support 4kHDR, 3D television, mobile television and other signal types required by future technologies.

"It means everything to our station that Comark has a solution for our broadcast needs that will serve our viewers today, but also prepares us for tomorrow with the transition to ATSC 3.0!" said Becky Magura, WCTE's President and CEO. "They treat WCTE as a true member of the Comark family and that speaks volumes about their CEO, Richard Fiore, and the entire Comark team! I am excited about the Parallax transmitter and grateful for the care and concern they give to our small, rural station."

Martin Luther: The Idea That Changed The World Monday, Sept. 12

The year 2017 marks the 500th anniversary of one of the most important events in western civilization—the birth of an idea that continues to shape the life of Americans today.

In 1517, power was in the hands of the few, thought was controlled by the chosen, and common people lived lives without hope. On October 31 of that year, a penniless monk named Martin Luther sparked the revolution that would change everything.

He had no army. In fact, he preached nonviolence so powerfully that—400 years later—Michael King would change his name to Martin Luther King to show solidarity with the original movement.

This movement, the Protestant Reformation, changed western culture at its core, sparking the drive toward individualism, freedom of religion, women's rights, separation of church and state, and even free public education. Without the Reformation, there would have been no Pilgrims, no Puritans, and no America in the way we know it.

The film follows the dramatic story of Martin Luther's life: the massive lightning storm that nearly killed him, the bleak self-punishment of his time in the monastery, the corruption that unleashed his anger, his trial before the most powerful man in Europe, and the staged kidnapping that helped him escape the death penalty. The film does not shy away from the darker side of the story, namely Luther's contribution to the rise of nationalism and the Nazi Holocaust.

The documentary features elaborate full-scale dramatizations filmed in the castles and monasteries and on the cobblestone streets of eastern Europe. Dozens of historians from Europe and the Americas were interviewed, with a careful eye to ensure that all sides of the story are represented.

The atelier staff survived the war, but now they face rivalries, romances, and scandal in the fashion capital of the world.

Richard Coyle (Coupling, Covert Affairs) and Tom Riley (Da Vinci's Demons) play Paul and Claude Sabine, two brothers with very different goals and lifestyles. Paul is the public face of the family's fashion house, and will stop at nothing to ensure it succeeds. Claude is the black sheep creative of the family who nevertheless produces all their designs. Everyone has secrets and pretty much everyone lies to everyone else.

Meanwhile their dresses are a sensation, and only a shady past, an inconvenient corpse, a conniving mother's actions and the growing competitive environment of the industry block the way to success.

Joining Coyle and Riley is an all-star supporting cast that includes *Vicious'* Frances de la Tour, *Foyle's War's* Michael Kitchen, *Broadchurch's* Sarah Parish, *Doctor Who's* Michelle Gomez and *Manhattan's* Mamie Gummer.

As you would hope and expect from a series centered around the fashion industry, the costuming for the series should get a screen credit as part of the supporting cast.

The Durrells in Corfu, Season 2 Sundays, October 15 - November 19

The Durrells, based on Gerald Durrell's trilogy of memoirs, follows the family's adventures in Corfu in the mid-1930s. Matriarch Louisa Durrell, in an attempt to avoid financial problems, uproots her four unruly 'children' Larry, Leslie, Margo and Gerry, from Bournemouth to start a new life on the beautiful island.

Larry will continue to pursue his passion for writing, despite a new romance getting in the way. Leslie explores his entrepreneurial side, while Margo remains boy crazy and makes a play for a thoroughly unsuitable person. As for Gerry, well, he still prefers animals to people, and is overjoyed when he discovers an otter living near their home.

Meanwhile, money is still tight for the Durrells and Louisa finds herself on the wrong side of their new landlady Vasilisa when she gets behind on paying the rent – it almost feels like Vasilisa, who is complexly inflexible, has a personal grudge towards Louisa, but why would that be? Louisa urges the family to brainstorm ideas to make some extra cash. They decide to grow food at home to sell at market. Theo tries to teach Leslie bee-keeping so he can make honey, Margo plants seeds and Gerry milks goats. Spiros is also on hand to offer support, but can they make a success of their new business venture?

Actor Daniel Lapine also joins the cast this season as Hugh Jarvis, a new love interest for Louisa. But after he failed at attempt at marrying Sven, will she be ready for a new man in her life?

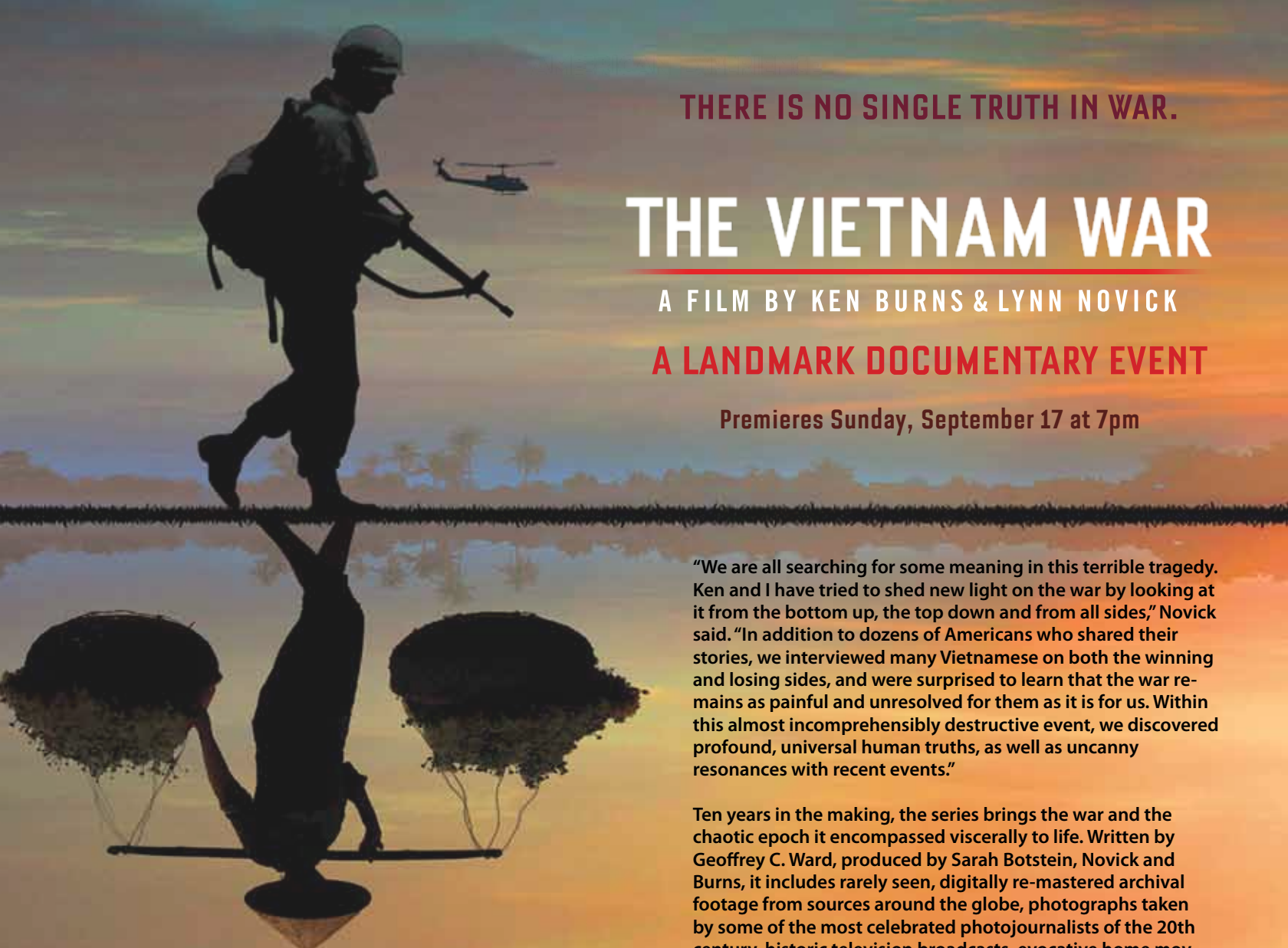

"We are all searching for some meaning in this terrible tragedy. Ken and I have tried to shed new light on the war by looking at it from the bottom up, the top down and from all sides," Novick said. "In addition to dozens of Americans who shared their stories, we interviewed many Vietnamese on both the winning and losing sides, and were surprised to learn that the war remains as painful and unresolved for them as it is for us. Within this almost incomprehensibly destructive event, we discovered profound, universal human truths, as well as uncanny resonances with recent events."

Ten years in the making, the series brings the war and the chaotic epoch it encompassed viscerally to life. Written by Geoffrey C. Ward, produced by Sarah Botstein, Novick and Burns, it includes rarely seen, digitally re-mastered archival footage from sources around the globe, photographs taken by some of the most celebrated photojournalists of the 20th century, historic television broadcasts, evocative home movies, and revelatory audio recordings from inside the Kennedy, Johnson and Nixon administrations.

The Vietnam War features new, original music written and recorded by Academy Award-winning composers Trent Reznor and Atticus Ross. The film also features new music arranged and performed by Grammy Award-winning cellist Yo-Yo Ma and The Silk Road Ensemble. It is the first time Burns and Novick have worked with Reznor and Ross, as well as with Yo-Yo Ma and The Silk Road Ensemble. Additional music in the film was composed by David Cieri and Doug Wamble, both of whom are longtime collaborators with Florentine Films.

The series also features more than 120 popular songs that define the era, including tracks from The Beatles, The Rolling Stones, Bob Dylan, Jimi Hendrix, Simon & Garfunkel, Janis Joplin, Ben E. King, Phil Ochs, Donovan, Johnny Cash, Barry McGuire, Buffalo Springfield, The Byrds, Otis Redding, Santana, Joni Mitchell, Nina Simone, The Temptations, Booker T. and the M.G.s, Pete Seeger and more.

The 10 part, 18-hour series that tells the epic story of the Vietnam War as it has never been told on film...

This all immersive new film from Ken Burns and Lynn Novick features testimony from nearly 80 witnesses, including many Americans who fought in the war and others who opposed it, as well as Vietnamese combatants and civilians from both the winning and losing sides.

"The Vietnam War was a decade of agony that took the lives of more than 58,000 Americans," Burns said. "Not since the Civil War have we as a country been so torn apart. There wasn't an American alive then who wasn't affected in some way — from those who fought and sacrificed in the war, to families of service members and POWs, to those who protested the war in open conflict with their government and fellow citizens. More than 40 years after it ended, we can't forget Vietnam, and we are still arguing about why it went wrong, who was to blame and whether it was all worth it."
