Tips for Bidding During the Live Broadcast

How to Bid - To bid on products seen on the Great TV Auction, call the number listed on the bottom of your screen during the live broadcast. One of our phone bank operators will be standing by to take your call.

Express Bidding - The fastest and easiest way to bid is to register for an express bid number. Simply call the number listed at the bottom of the screen during the Great TV Auction to receive your Express Bidder Number.

Bid High - The high bid on the board may not necessarily be the last bid - we have approximately 20 operators taking bids at any given time, so you've got some competition out there. Bid high and leave the timid bidders behind.

Overbid Incentives - If you bid higher than the posted retail value of an item, not only do you increase your chances of winning, but if you do win, you'll receive extra overbid incentives! In addition, Budweiser will match your overbid with donations of up to \$1,500 to WCTE! Everybody wins when you overbid!

The CPB Board of Directors To Visit WCTE in June

This June will be a first for WCTE. The entire Corporation for Public Broadcasting (CPB) Board of Directors will be making a site visit to our station, our partners, our community and even receive a firsthand experience with *Bluegrass Underground* at Cumberland Caverns.

Created by Congress in 1967, the CPB's "mission is to ensure universal access, over-the-air and online, to high-quality content and telecommunications services that are commercial free and free of charge. It does this in conjunction with non-commercial educational telecommunications licensees across America."

The CPB Board of Directors are appointed by the President of the United States and confirmed by the U.S. Senate. They will spend time in Tennessee visiting WCTE and Nashville Public Television and will be accompanied by CPB President and CEO, Patricia de Stacy Harrison as well as many key CPB staff.

I can't even begin to tell you how excited I am about their decision to visit WCTE. This is a wonderful affirmation of

the importance of our work and the service we bring to our region. We all know that anytime we have a chance to bring others to our community and region, they leave with a sense of appreciation for the collaborative environment that makes the Upper Cumberland a great place to live and work.

This is an opportunity I could not have imagined for our WCTE staff and trustees, but one for which I am grateful. We will have face-to-face time with these remarkable leaders to share the mission and importance of public media in a rural region by one of the smallest stations in the country.

WCTE has been serving the Upper Cumberland since 1978. Our mission of education, locally produced content and community engagement will be highlighted as we give the CPB Board of Directors a taste of Upper Cumberland hospitality.

WCTE was recently awarded a \$10,000 Community Impact Grant from New York Life. The grant will support a career exploration program for area 8th graders, using the PBS Roadtrip Nation program and curriculum.

"I'm proud to work for a company that encourages its agents and employees to devote their time, energy, and talents to support the needs and priorities of their local community," said Andrea Burckhard, an agent associated with the company's Knoxville General Office and the person responsible for nominating WCTE

to receive the grant. "We are pleased that our partnership will have a long-lasting impact on WCTE and the population they serve."

The Community Impact Grant program awards grants of up to \$25,000 to local nonprofit organizations which are championed by New York Life agents and employees to serve the needs of their local communities. Since the program's inception in 2008, 387 grants totaling more than \$5 million have been awarded to nonprofits across the country.

DISCOVER THE UPPER CUMBERLAND

GRASSY COVE, CUMBERLAND COUNTY

In upcoming months *Discover the Upper Cumberland* invites you to travel with us into Cumberland County to explore what has been called the largest sinkhole in North America. Grassy Cove is a unique place tucked amongst steep mountain chains, and is one of the hidden wonders of the Upper Cumberland region.



The small unincorporated community of Grassy Cove was established in the early 1800's by a caravan of settlers traveling from Virginia, including the founder, John Ford. Cleared and standing in tall grass, wildflowers, buffalo, elk and deer, it was said that John Ford stood on the side of a mountain, peering at the cove and knew this was an ideal location for a community.

In 1803, a log structure to hold the congregation of the Grassy Cove United Methodist Church was built. This was one of the first congregations in the Cumberland Plateau region. In 1808 Conrad Kemmer and his family found their way to Grassy Cove from Pennsylvania and many of his descendants still reside there today.

The landscape remains relatively unchanged since then. The rain-water flowing down from the surrounding steep mountains makes its way to the northern edge of the cove by way of the Grassy Cove Creek. It then drops into Mill Cave on the side of Brady Mountain before emerging again, over 80 miles south of the cove as the headwaters of the Sequatchie River in the Sequatchie Valley.

On the eastern slope of Brady Mountain you will find Grassy Cove Saltpeter Cave, one of the 100 longest caves in the United States and the eleventh longest in Tennessee. Windlass Cave, Bristow Cave, Milksick Cave and the most recently discovered Robert's Pit are a few more of the natural wonders found on or around this property. If you investigate closely in the cool darkness of the caves you will find the endangered long eared bat. Take a stroll a little farther along the property and you will find the uncommon Dusky Green Salamander dwelling in the purity of the cold mountain streams.

Green grasslands, livestock and the occasional barn or farmhouse sparsely decorate the cove bottom without distracting from the natural beauty. Grassy Cove has been designated a national natural landmark and only one of thirteen in the state of Tennessee, but the property remains primarily privately owned.



The Kemmer family has enjoyed this land for hundreds of years. Over two million dollars needs to be raised to designate this treasure as an addition to the Cumberland Trail State Park. American Masters presents *Janis: Little Girl Blue* Premiering May 3

One of the most revered and influential rock 'n' roll singers of all time, Janis Joplin (January 19, 1943 - October 4, 1970) thrilled audiences and blazed new creative trails before her death at age 27. Oscar-nominated director Amy Berg examines Joplin's story in depth, for the first time on film, presenting an intimate portrait of a complicated and driven artist.

Original interviews with Joplin's siblings Laura and Michael, friends, lovers and fellow musicians, including Big Brother and the Holding Company bandmates Peter Albin, Sam Andrew and Dave Getz, Bob Weir (Grateful Dead), Country Joe McDonald (Country Joe and the Fish), Kris Kristofferson, Dick Cavett and Clive Davis, give a complete sense of someone haunted by insecurity and a need for acceptance throughout her life, despite her on-stage bravado and uninhibited, sexualized persona.

Exploring her childhood, struggles with addiction, active role in the musical and cultural revolution of the 1960s, surprising rise to stardom and untimely demise, Joplin's own words tell much of her story through a series of letters she wrote to her parents - many of them made public for the first time - and read by Chan Marshall.

"The only way to tell Janis' story was through Janis' voice. Her letters show the vulnerable artist, daughter and lover Janis was in her short but impactful life," said writer, director and producer Amy Berg.


MASTERPIECE Endeavor Season 3 Four Part Series Premiering June 19

In private life, he bonds with Linda's father-in-law, a retired naval officer, who gets a menacing birthday greeting. Convinced that something is not right with his brain, Wallander sees a doctor.

THE TROUBLED MAN

His memory is going to pieces and he's no longer officially on duty, but Wallander draws on all his resources to find Linda's missing father-in-law, a former top official in the Swedish navy, who is obsessed with a decades-old submarine mystery. Slowly losing his grip on reality, Wallander is desperate to solve this one last case.
