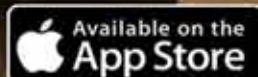

WCTE Radio Shows Receive National Attention

WCTE's Director of Education and Community Engagement, Dr. Hannah Rawiszer, and WCTE's Ready To Learn Project Manager, Cindy Putman, recently shared the story of WCTE's partnership/collaboration with Zimmer Broadcasting at the National Educational Telecommunication Association (NETA) conference in Baltimore. NETA is a professional association that connects public television people and ideas, and the partnership between WCTE and Zimmer Broadcasting was of significant interest.

"The Community Engagement Council of NETA is comprised of individuals from PBS stations across the country who are doing significant work in community engagement and outreach," commented Hannah. "WCTE is honored to be included with this group of outstanding leaders in public media."

The media partnership between WCTE and Zimmer Broadcasting is a natural one. Both organizations are committed to serving our communities. The collaborative nature of the radio shows enables us to engage guests who have local ties to programming and education topics, to reach a new audience, and to enhance our service to the region.

There are two 30-minute WCTE radio shows.

WCTE PBS: On the Radio, hosted by Hannah, informs the radio audience about upcoming WCTE events and features special guests. Seth Stanger delivers the scintillating details on upcoming PBS and local programming that you won't want to miss.

WCTE's Get Ready To Learn with Cindy Putman features a weekly co-host who discusses a topic of interest to educators, parents, caregivers, and children.

Both shows are produced by the award-winning Brent Carl Fleshman. You can tune into WCTE is on News Talk 1400 WHUB and 107.7 FM every Saturday morning at 9 a.m.

Small Market Personality of the Year!

The National Association of Broadcasting recently presented Brent Carl Fleshman of Zimmer Broadcasting a prestigious Marconi Award, naming him the **Small Market Personality of the Year**. Brent is the Program Director and WHUB and WPTN. He is also the host of **Good Morning Cookeville** and the producer of our two shows, **WCTE/PBS: On the Radio** and **WCTE's Get Ready To Learn with Cindy Putman**.

Brent competed against nominees from Montana, Maryland, Minnesota and Illinois. As part of the nomination process, Brent had to submit a 200-word essay about how involved the station, and how involved he was in the community. In the essay, he shared information about the station's partnership with WCTE and with the "Stand with the Shield" program in support of law enforcement. The finalists were selected by a task force of broadcasters and were voted on by the NAB Marconi Radio Awards Selection Academy.

"While the station has always been involved with the community, the owner, Jerry Zimmer, and I sat down and talked about wanting to be an even bigger part," Brent told WCTE earlier this year. "We wanted to make it more about the people. We wanted to give back."

Our congratulations go out to Brent and to Zimmer Broadcasting. Thank you for giving back the community and to the Upper Cumberland.

FAMILY CREATIVE WORKSHOPS



WCTE's Community Collaboratives for Early Learning Media members (Putnam County Library and Putnam County Schools Extended Learning Program LEAPS and 21st Century) recently conducted Family Creative Workshops at the Putnam County Library and Jere Whitson Elementary. Families explored computer coding using the PBS KIDS Scratch Jr app and created a project using collaboration, creativity and coding with their kids.

What Is ScratchJr?

ScratchJr is an introductory programming language that enables young children (ages 5-7) to create their own interactive stories and games. Children snap together graphical programming blocks to make characters move, jump, dance, and sing. Children can modify characters in the paint editor, add their own voices and sounds, even insert photos of themselves -- then use the programming blocks to make their characters come to life.

Why Is It Important To Learn Coding?

Coding (or computer programming) is a new type of literacy. Just as writing helps you organize your thinking and express your

ideas, the same is true for coding. In the past, coding was seen as too difficult for most people, but it does not have to be. Coding should be for everyone, just like writing.

As young children code with ScratchJr, they learn how to create and express themselves with the computer, not just to interact with it. In the process, children learn to solve problems and design projects, and they develop sequencing skills that are foundational for later academic success. They also use math and language in a meaningful and motivating context, supporting the development of early-childhood numeracy and literacy. With ScratchJr, children aren't just learning to code, they are coding to learn.

The Battle of Chosin Tuesday, November 1

On Thanksgiving Day 1950, American-led United Nations troops were on the march in North Korea. U.S. Marine and Air Force pilots distributed holiday meals, even to those on the front lines. Hopes were high that everyone would be home by Christmas. But soon after that peaceful celebration, American military leaders, including General Douglas MacArthur, were caught off guard by the entrance of the People's Republic of China, led by Mao Zedong, into the five-month-old Korean War. Twelve thousand men of the First Marine Division, along with a few thousand Army soldiers, suddenly found themselves surrounded, outnumbered and at risk of annihilation at the Chosin Reservoir, high in the mountains of North Korea. The two-week battle that followed, fought in brutally cold temperatures, is one of the most celebrated in Marine Corps annals and helped set the course of American foreign policy in the Cold War and beyond.

The only hope for the surrounded men was to fight their way back to the coast, a perilous journey into the teeth of a subarctic winter, through tens of thousands of Chinese soldiers waiting in the high ground above the single road out. For the next two weeks, General Smith's men fought brutal battles against the Chinese in some of the harshest conditions American forces had ever experienced. Dead bodies, frozen in grotesque and contorted shapes, littered the battlefield. Finally, 14,000 surviving troops made their way back to safety.

Incorporating interviews with more than 20 veterans of the campaign, *The Battle of Chosin* recounts this epic conflict through the heroic stories of the men who fought it.

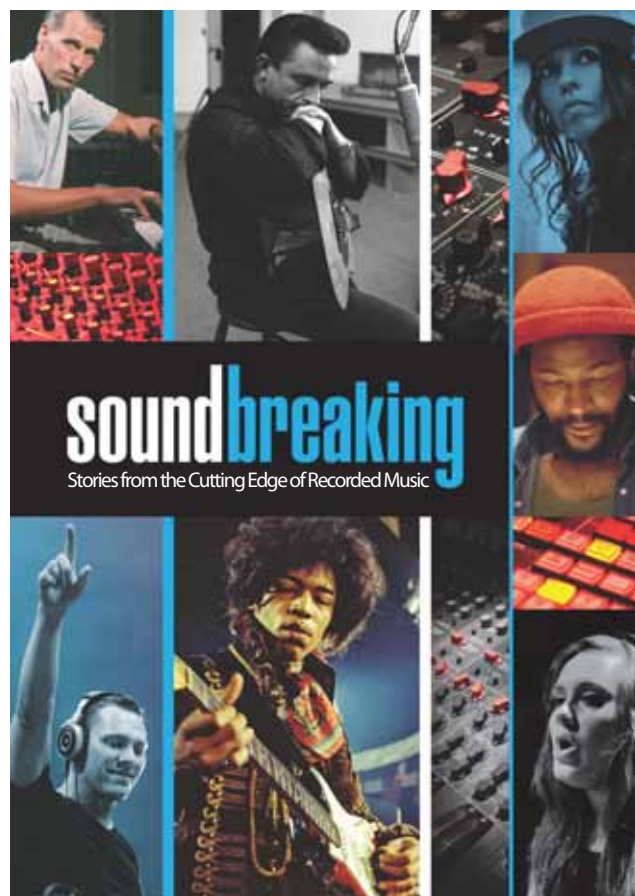

Anne of Green Gables

Thursday, November 24

L.M. MONTGOMERY'S *ANNE OF GREEN GABLES* tells the story of Anne Shirley, a precocious young girl taken from an orphanage and placed in the care of the uptight Marilla Cuthbert and her brother, Matthew. The conservative Marilla has a profound effect on the adventurous Anne and creates a journey of learning and personal engagement that has resonated with generations since L.M. Montgomery's *Anne of Green Gables* was first published in 1908. The book remains an iconic work of Canadian literature and has sold more than 50 million copies worldwide.

Directed by John Kent Harrison and based on the original script by Susan Coyne, this adaptation, filmed in Canada, stars critically acclaimed actor Martin Sheen. Sheen who portrays Matthew Cuthbert, one half of the brother-sister couple who care for Anne Shirley.

"The story and Anne character have become a staple of childhood innocence and inspiration," Michael Kelley, senior vp programming and business affairs at PBS. SUNDAYS, DECEMBER 11 - 25

The feeble King Henry is overshadowed by Queen Margaret and her faction of Lancastrian Lords, his reign further undermined by disaffected nobles supporting the House of York. Battle and bloodshed ensues and the Yorkists triumph. Edward IV takes the thrown, but his youngest brother Richard has his eyes firmly on the crown.

RICHARD III DEC. 25

Richard, the most notorious of Shakespeare's kings, manipulates and betrays his way through the court on a bloodthirsty and ruthless path to the throne. But after Richard's defeat at the battle of Bosworth Field, the Houses of Lancaster and York—the red rose and the white—are united, bringing to an end the Wars of the Roses and long tumultuous period of civil strife.
