Local History	LST-325: History on the Riverfront	9-1: 4/18/10	10:30pm	30 minutes	This locally-produced documentary featured a tour of the local LST-325 ship and focused on it's history in Evansville and the life of many local veterans.
Local Culture	Frog Follies	9-1: 4/8/10	9:30pm	30 minutes	This local program featured the many people and old cars that make up the annual Eville Frog Follies. Interviews with participants showcase the history of the event and the impact it has on the local economy.
Local Politics	8 <sup>th</sup> District Republican Congressional Debate	9-1: 4/28/10	7:00pm	90 minutes	This live debate was hosted by the League of Women Voters of Southwestern Indiana and featured the Republican Candidate for Indiana's 8 <sup>th</sup> District.
Local Environment	Newsmakers	9-1: 5/14/10	9:00pm	30 minutes	Roberta Heiman, President of the Evansville Area Trails Coalition was interviewed by host Mizell Stewart and explained the plans for building more trails in Evansville which will aid in making the local population more healthy.
Downtown Revitalization	Newsmakers	9-1: 5/21/10	9:00pm	30 minutes	David Owen from the Evansville Convention and Visitor's Bureau talked with Mizell Stewart about the progress of the new arena and it's economic impact on downtown Evansville.
Local Government	Newsmakers	9-1: 6/18/10	9:00pm	30 minutes	Rebecca Kasha, head of the Evansville Vanderburgh County Reorganization Committee discussed the progress and problems with plans to consolidate Vanderburgh County and Evansville.
Education	Tri-State Focus	9-1: 5/7/10	8:30pm	30 minutes	This locally-produced episode focused on the topic of New Technology in the Evansville/Vanderburgh School Corporation and featured interviews with personnel responsible for the implementation of the new NetBooks and other technologies.
Disaster Preparedness	Tri-State Focus	9-1: 5/14/10	8:30pm	30 minutes	This episode featured a brief history on past disasters, and the information on possible future disasters and how to best be prepared for them.

In addition to the reported programs, WNIN regularly tapes and airs various speakers and presentations that have a local interest.. During the 2nd quarter of 2010, WNIN provided the following content on 9-2: Sandra Appler from the Census discussing the importance of completing the questionnaire, A Indiana Court of Appeals argument taped at USI, a local health conference by the Health department, the EVSC Superintendent's State of the Schools presentation, and the Indiana Regulatory Hearings regarding the proposed utility rate increase.
