| Local Culture | EVSC Community Link | 5/26/12 | 5:00pm | 30 minutes | This series, produced by the students of Bosse High School features various topics and local personalities. Topics range from a look at the Boy's Club of Evansville to hunting safety. |
| Local Culture | Mesker Park Zoo and Botanical Garden | 5/5/12 | 6:00pm | 30 minutes | This locally-produced program featured the Mesker Park Zoo and Botanical Gardens. Viewers had the opportunity to tour the Zoo, including the new Amazonia exhibit, and learn about this valuable resource that is available in their backyard. |
