For example, buying produced from a local farmer's market as opposed to produce shipped from Mexico. The episode also featured various products manufactured in the Evansville Tri-State area.
Politics	Election 2014	9/24/14	8:00pm	90 minutes	This live series of debates featured the candidates for Vanderburgh County Sheriff, Vanderburgh County Commission District 2, Vanderburgh County County Council District 3, and Vanderburgh County Auditor. The special was sponsored by the League of Women Voters of Southwestern Indiana, and the Evansville Courier Press.
Air Pollution/Health	Healthy Air: Healthy Communities 118	9/9/14	7:00pm	30 minutes	This episode focused on three topics. The new mpg standards and the effect it will have on new cars and the emission from the vehicles, the limited use of solar cars and the pros and cons of solar cars, and the future use and applications of unmanned vehicles as they may relate to delivery of products, search and rescue and other duties.
Veteran Issues	Carry Forward: Tri-State Vets Back Home	7/3/14	7:30pm	30 minutes	This special featured various local veterans as they described the trials and hardships they faced upon their return from service and how they utilized local service to aid in the reintegration.
Air Pollution/Health	Healthy Air: Healthy Communities 118	7/29/14	7:00pm	30 minutes	This episode looked the link between driving less and being healthier. It included interviews with people who regularly walk and bike to work, medical reps who discussed the health benefits, and several new phone apps that track physical activities and calories burned.
History	WNIN's Top 9 101 Weather Disasters	7/17/14	8:30pm	30 minutes	This episode looked at the history of major weather disasters in the Tri-State area including major floods, recent and past tornadoes, and winter storms. Local meteorologists and witnesses described the worst weather events in the Tri-State's history.
History	WNIN's Top 9 104 Historic Buildings in Evansville	9/6/14	8:30pm	30 minutes	This episode looked at the top 9 most interesting historic structures in Evansville and their significance on the city's history
