Many of our members are travel enthusiasts and have asked for opportunities to continue their broadcast explorations with hands-on group travel experiences with other members who share their curiosity about the world. In the last two years, Vegas PBS has designed trips around some of our most popular programs: science, nature and the arts.

This summer we have taken a group of adventurous members on a science excursion to Los Angeles to visit the Space Shuttle Endeavor and the Griffith Observatory. We have taken our train lovers on an excursion to Verde Canyon in Sedona and the Grand Canyon on vintage locomotives. Coming up are our popular trips to Cedar City for the Utah Shakespeare Festival and the Neil Simon Festival to experience live theater in a beautiful outdoor setting. Local concerts with prime seating and meet-and-greet experiences with Andrea Bocelli, Chris Mann and Straight No Chaser are also in the events pipeline.

More than 400 people have participated in these extended learning trips and performances in the last twelve months. We relish the opportunity to create these program-related experiences and to meet our viewers and supporters face to face. # Masterpiece Mystery! Endeavour, Series I

Set in 1960s Oxford, the series is written by “Inspector Lewis” creator and “Inspector Morse” writer Russell Lewis. Acclaimed stage and screen actor Roger Allam (“Parade’s End,” “The Thick of It”) is back as Morse’s senior partner and mentor,

**B**efore Inspector Morse, there was the rookie Constable Morse, fed up with police work and ready to nip his career in the bud by handing in his resignation. That is, until a murder turned up that only he could solve.

Following on the success of the 2011 “Endeavour” pilot, Shaun Evans returns in four new episodes as the young Endeavour Morse – before his signature red Jaguar but with his deductive powers already running in high gear.

Detective Inspector Fred Thursday, and Sean Rigby takes on the role of the young, competitive PC Strange, a character who appeared in the original "Inspector Morse" series. Shakespearean actor Anton Lesser ("Little Dorrit") plays the imposing new Oxford Police Chief Superintendent Bright, and John Thaw's daughter Abigail Thaw returns in guest appearances as journalist Dorothea Frazil.

## July 7 The Girl

DC Morse (Shaun Evans) and DI Thursday (Roger Allam) investigate burgled gas meters, the sudden death of a young secretarial student and a string of Post Office robberies, confounding the solution to a pair of violent murders. Could Morse's future on the force be in jeopardy?

## July 14 Fugue

Morse and Thursday are confronted with a new breed of murderer, as a string of Oxford homicides continues with no end in sight. The entire police department is working around the clock and a special expert comes on to assist, but Morse's love of opera may be the key to stopping the killing.

## July 21 Rocket

A royal visit to a family-owned munitions factory begins as a proud occasion for the people of Oxford, but the joyous day ends with murder. Morse delves into the family's murky past, as well as his own, as he attempts to uncover the culprit before more lives are lost.

## July 28 Home

While studying for his upcoming sergeant's exam, Morse investigates the hit-and-run death of an eminent Oxford professor. The pressure mounts with his father's illness and the appearance of an enemy threatening to reveal aspects of Inspector Thursday's past. In the end, Morse must choose between the responsibilities of his job and loyalty to his mentor.

# Exploration Wednesday

**Wednesday, July 3 from 8 p.m. to 11 p.m. on Vegas PBS Channel 10 and 10.1**

**S**pend an evening with our friends from the animal kingdom. The night begins with **Nature: American Eagle at 8 p.m.** Everything about them is big. They are one of nature's largest raptors, with wings that can span eight feet, and nests that can weigh up to a ton. Yet most people know little about it beyond its striking appearance. From the pristine wilderness of Alaska to the Upper Mississippi River Valley, this special goes behind the scenes and into the nest to provide the ultimate bird's eye view into the private life of an American icon.

At 9 p.m., **NOVA: Dogs Decoded** reveals the science behind the remarkable bond between humans and their dogs and investigates new discoveries in genetics that

are illuminating the origin of dogs—with surprising implications for the evolution of human culture. Other research is proving what dog lovers have suspected all along: dogs have an uncanny ability to read and respond to human emotions. Humans, in turn, respond to dogs with the same hormone responsible for bonding mothers to their babies.

The love of pets continues with **Shelter Me: Let's Go Home at 10 p.m.** This inspiring program celebrates shelter pets with stories about people's lives being improved when they adopt a shelter pet, as these pets go from rescued to rescuer. Some individuals have adopted shelter dogs and are now volunteering at hospitals. Also featured is an amazing story about our hero firefighters who train shelter dogs for search-and-rescue. Every year, 3-4 million dogs and cats are euthanized in America's shelters and adoptions give these incredible animals a second chance. The documentary is about hope, helping others and making a difference.

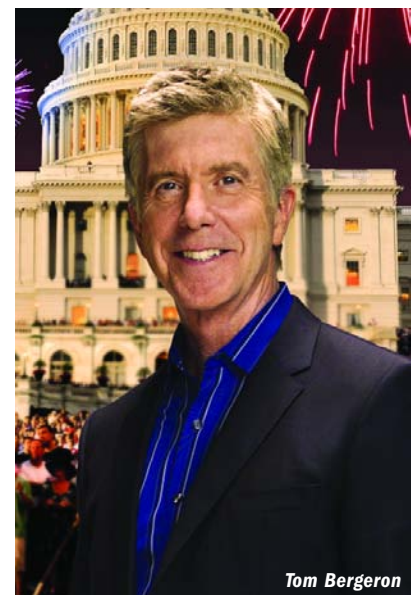

## Video Transforms Teaching and Learning

**W**e continue to live through an age of ever-changing technology and information. In recent years, smart phones, tablets, mobile apps and social media sites such as Facebook and Twitter impacted lives in profound ways. Certainly education has changed as devices, applications and learning styles evolve.

The growth of online content and digital resources along with innovative tools and methods has all helped teachers educate students. This trend was identified in a recent article in *Education Week*, among many other sources, and highlights how a dramatic increase in digital video has led the way and provides a huge impact on teaching and student learning.

Vegas PBS has been actively involved in integrating video and providing online video streaming services to local schools and the community for many years. In Clark County School District classrooms alone, we have provided millions of streams and downloads representing tens of thousands of videos segments and other digital resources to local teachers, helping them reach new generations of students.

This explosion of instructional video content has major implications for student learning both inside and outside of the classroom. With multiple technological options, students can access instructional video content “anywhere and anytime,” allowing them to extend learning opportunities. If students are going to be constantly accessing technology, having access to a massive library of instructionally correlated videos and digital resources allows for substantial learning outside of the classroom. In addition, virtual or online courses will typically have embedded video segments to highlight concepts, assist students with visualizing content and keep their interest in the subject matter.

In the classroom, teachers constantly have to strive to find innovative ways to keep students engaged, and videos can provide that hook to keep students learning. Students create and integrate their own videos along with existing resources to create new instructional units and learning opportunities. These new models also allow teachers to give students new ways to master content outside of a traditional lecture format.

Integrating video and other digital resources to have a positive impact on student learning helps keep the important work of teachers fresh and engaging, and represents a change for the best.

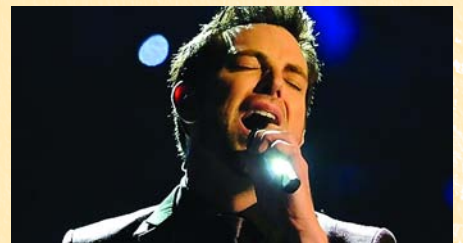

# Exploring Ancient Egypt

*Vegas PBS takes you back in time to explore the mysteries of exotic ancient Egypt with two fascinating specials.*

**Wednesday, July 10 from 8 - 11 p.m. on Vegas PBS Channel 10 and 10.1**

**T**he evening begins with **NOVA: Building Pharaoh's Chariot at 8 p.m.** Some historians claim that the Egyptian chariot launched a technological and strategic revolution and was the secret weapon behind Egypt's greatest era of conquest known as the New Kingdom. But was the chariot really a revolutionary design? How decisive was its role in the bloody battles of the ancient world? A team of archaeologists, engineers, woodworkers and horse trainers builds and tests two accurate replicas of Egyptian royal chariots. Driving them to their limits in the desert outside Cairo, experts test the claim that the chariot marks a crucial turning point in ancient military history. **Repeats Sunday, July 14 at 9 a.m.**

Following at **9 p.m., Secrets of the Dead: Ultimate Tut** delves into the greatest archaeological find in history. Ninety years ago in Egypt's Valley of the Kings, Tutankhamen's tomb and its golden treasures were discovered. It made Tutankhamen the most famous name in ancient Egyptian history. But the real story has become shrouded in myth – with many mysteries around the tomb unsolved to

this day. Now this two-hour special brings together the latest evidence from a team of archaeologists, anatomists, geologists and Egyptologists, to build the ultimate picture of Tutankhamen. Blending 3D graphics, stylized reconstruction and action-adventure forensic investigation, we take a 21st-century approach to ancient history. We will follow genuinely new scientific research and present fresh insights into how Tutankhamen was buried, why his tomb was the only one to remain intact, and the enduring enigma around how he died.

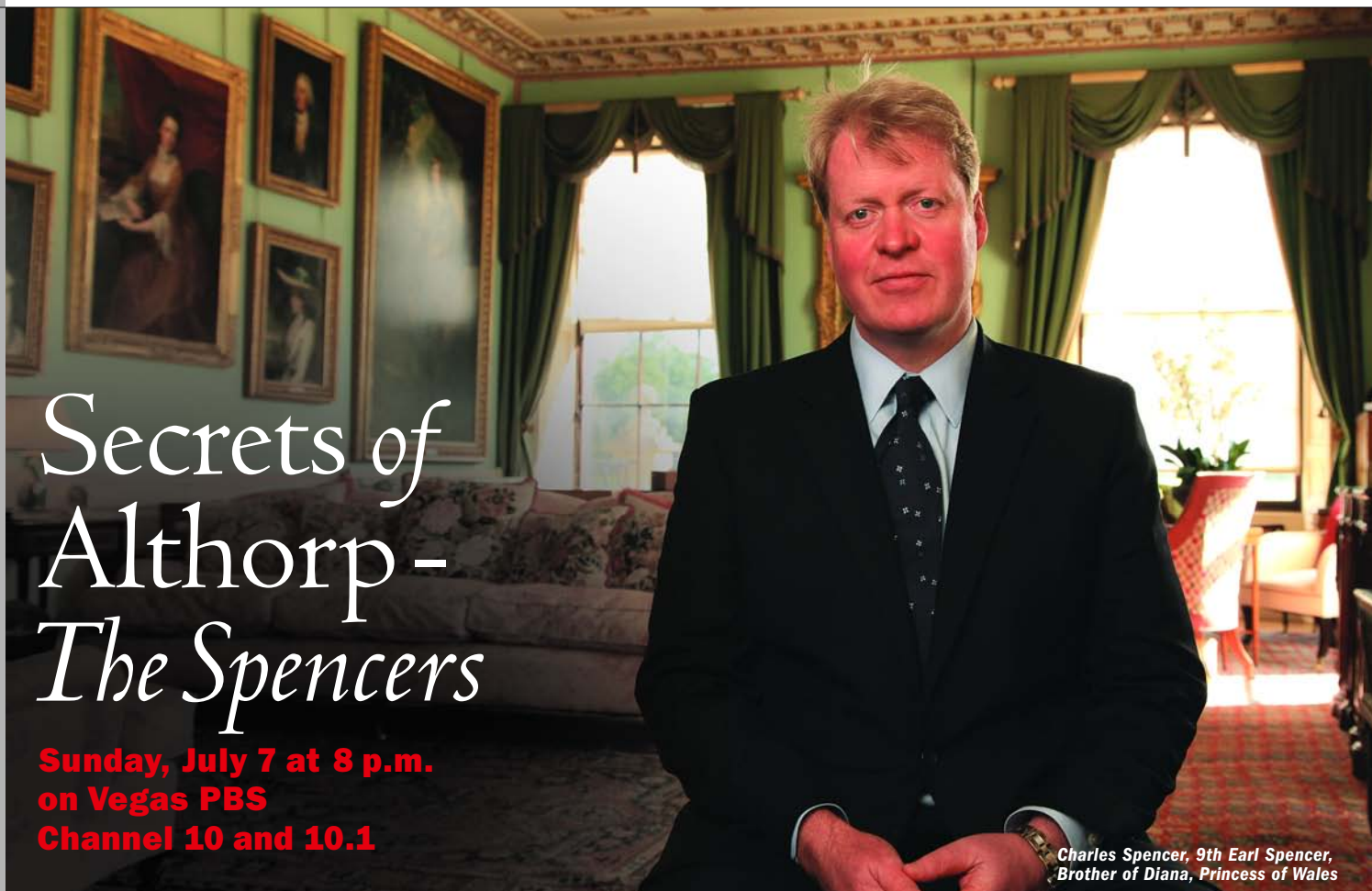

# Secrets of Althorp - The Spencers

**A**lthorp, childhood home and final resting place of Princess Diana, is currently the home of Diana's brother, Charles, the 9th Earl Spencer. Nineteen generations of Spencers have presided over this grand estate for more than 500 years. The Spencer dynasty has produced politicians, military heroes, dukes and duchesses and will one day furnish Britain with a king: Diana's son, Prince William. Noted for their generosity, the Spencers once came to the rescue of a distant cousin fallen on hard times: the great-great-grandfather of George Washington. Althorp House has hosted some of the kingdom's most distinguished guests, and its rooms have witnessed scenes of great celebration: the first earl's secret wedding to his sweetheart and most recently, the marriage of

the current earl, who takes viewers on a personal tour around the noble manor that's first of all his family home. **Repeats Sunday, July 14 at 7 p.m.**

## Secrets of Chatsworth

In its 500-year history, Chatsworth has been home to some notable inhabitants, among them the 5th Duke of Devonshire, his wife, Lady Georgiana Spencer, and Lady Elizabeth Foster, who lived together in a ménage à trois. King Edward VII enjoyed shooting parties on the estate and was often entertained by

Duchess Louisa, one of Britain's foremost political hostesses. Duchess Louisa's daughter-in-law, American Consuelo Yznaga del Valle, introduced American heiresses into the British aristocracy; many of these young women married British noblemen. Billy Cavendish, heir of the 10th Duke of Devonshire, wooed and wed Kathleen Kennedy, the sister of future U.S. president John F. Kennedy. The marriage was short-lived, however: Billy died in action in World War II four months after they exchanged vows. Four years later, Kathleen died in a plane crash. She was buried at Chatsworth. **Repeats Sunday, July 21 at 7 p.m.**



**S**tar tenor Jonas Kaufmann sings the title role in a new production of Wagner's final masterpiece, staged by acclaimed French Canadian director François Girard.

The extraordinary cast of Wagnerians assembled for the deeply meditative opera about sin, redemption, pain, and healing includes German bass René Pape; Swedish soprano Katarina Dalayman; Swedish baritone Peter Mattel as the wounded king Amfortas; and Russian bass-baritone Evgeny Nikitin as the evil wizard Klingsor. Italian maestro Daniele Gatti conducts Wagner's powerful and complex score.

The Associated Press found this production to be "(a) Parsifal to treasure, elevated to the highest musical level by the solemnity and sweep of Daniele Gatti's conducting and the dedication of a dream cast of singing actors." American bass-baritone Eric Owens hosts the broadcast and conducts backstage interviews with the stars.

Stephen Ambrose, the historian, has said of Ken's films, "More Americans get their history from Ken Burns than any other source." This month, Vegas PBS has brought together some of the most compelling and intriguing of his films that bring to life pivotal events in American history.

## The Statue of Liberty

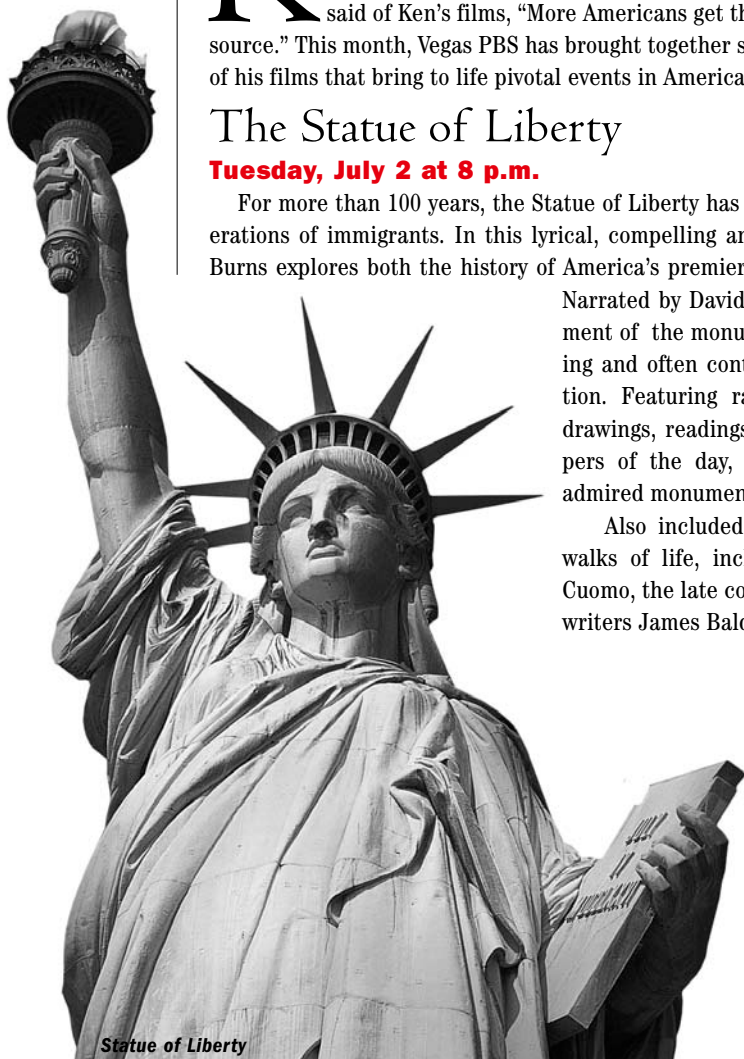
**Tuesday, July 2 at 8 p.m.**

For more than 100 years, the Statue of Liberty has been a symbol of hope and refuge for generations of immigrants. In this lyrical, compelling and provocative portrait of the statue, Ken Burns explores both the history of America's premier symbol and the meaning of liberty itself.

Narrated by David McCullough, the film traces the development of the monument – from its conception to its fascinating and often controversial construction to its final dedication. Featuring rare archival photographs, paintings and drawings, readings from actual diaries, letters and newspapers of the day, the fascinating story of this universally admired monument is told.

Also included are interviews with Americans from all walks of life, including former New York governor Mario Cuomo, the late congresswoman Barbara Jordan and the late writers James Baldwin and Jerzy Kosinski.

## The Civil War

**Sunday, July 7 from Noon to 7 p.m. and  
Sunday, July 14 from Noon to 5 p.m.**

In 1990, Ken Burns' epic documentary brought to life America's most destructive – and defining conflict. This series was most highly-watched program ever on PBS, attracting more than 40 million viewers and has been honored with more than 40 major film and television awards.

Immerse yourself in the profound drama of the Civil War as Vegas PBS presents the series in its entirety over two Sundays. The program is the saga of celebrated generals and ordinary soldiers, a heroic and transcendent president and a country that had to divide itself in two in order to become one. Voices for the series include Sam Waterston, Jason Robards, Jeremy Irons, Morgan Freeman, Garrison Keillor, Arthur Miller and many others. Historian David McCullough narrates.

In an interview, Burns observes, "I realized that we had taken longer to make a film about the Civil War than it took the nation to fight it in the first place. But the long and painstaking process had permitted me to refine a filmmaking style that we had been evolving for more than 10 years."

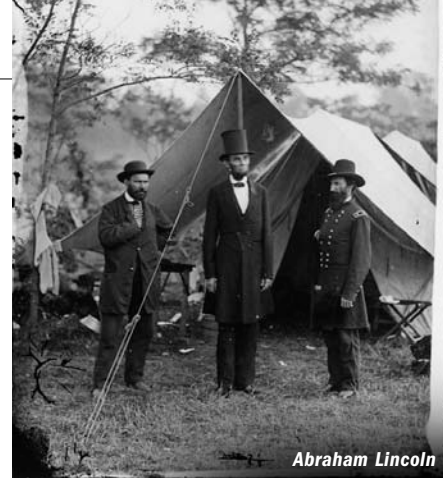
Sent by President Thomas Jefferson to find the fabled Northwest Passage, Meriwether Lewis and William Clark led the most important expedition in American history – a voyage of danger and discovery from St. Louis to the headwaters of the Missouri River, over the Continental Divide to the Pacific. It was the United States' first exploration of the West and one of the nation's most enduring adventures. This program tells the remarkable story of the entire corps – not just the two famous captains, but the young army men, French-Canadian boatmen, Clark's African-American slave and the Shoshone woman, Sacagawea, who brought along her infant son. ## The Dust Bowl

**Sunday, July 21 from 1 to 5 p.m.**

This compelling film chronicles the environmental catastrophe that, throughout the 1930s, destroyed farmlands of the Great Plains, turned prairies into deserts and unleashed a pattern of massive, deadly dust storms that for many seemed to herald the end of the world. Once a drought hit in 1931, winds began picking up soil from the open fields and grew into dust storms of biblical proportions. Each year for nearly a decade, the storms grew more ferocious and more frequent, sweeping up millions of tons of earth, killing crops and livestock, threatening to turn the southern plains into a Sahara, even spreading the dust clear across the country.

The documentary uses compelling interviews with 26 survivors of those hard times – what will probably be the last recorded testimony of the generation that lived through the Dust Bowl. Filled with seldom-seen movie footage, previously unpublished photographs, and the observations of two remarkable women who left behind eloquent written accounts, the film is also a historical accounting of what happened and why during the 1930s on the southern plains.

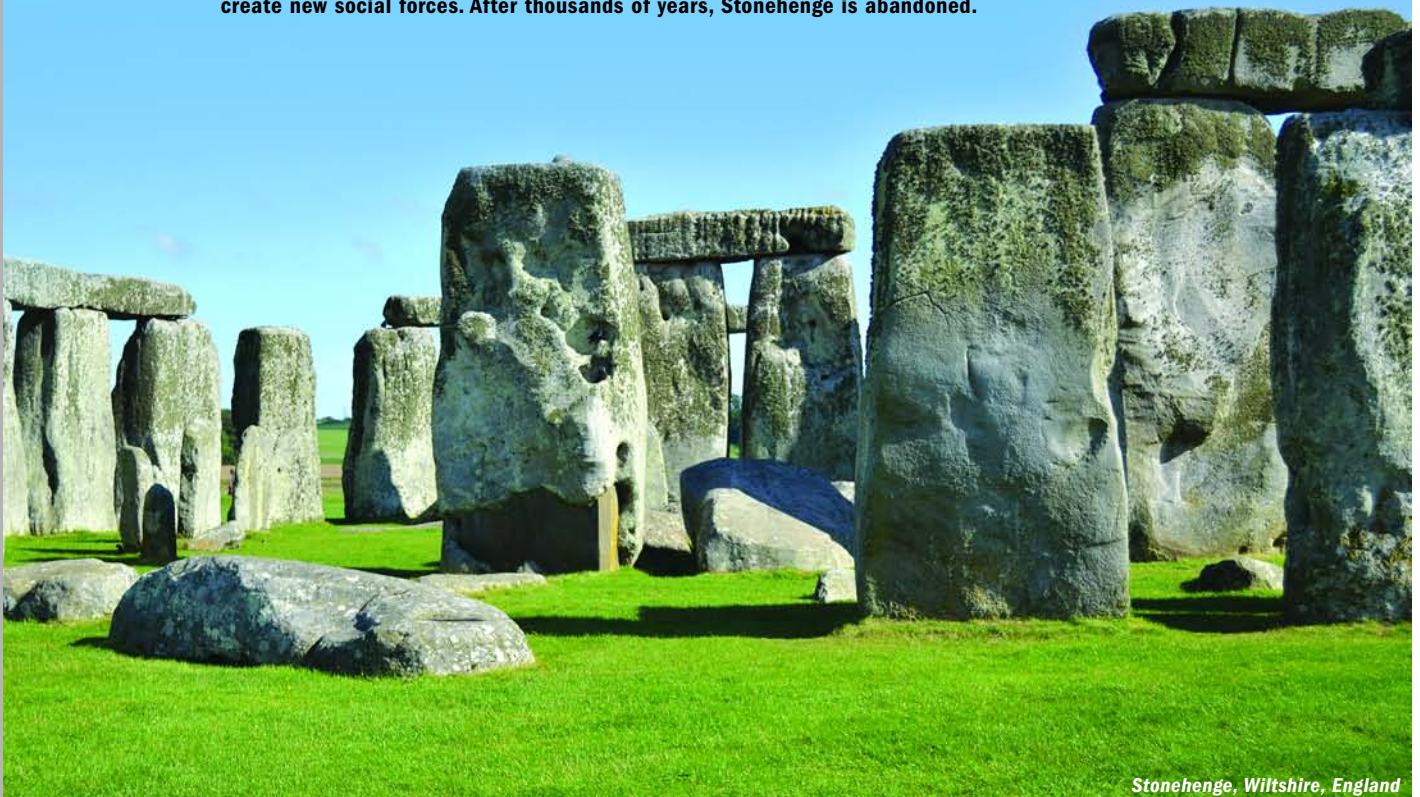

# Nazi Mega Weapons

In the quest for world domination, the Nazis built some of the biggest and deadliest pieces of military hardware and malevolent technology in history. With brilliant, dark minds and a legion of captive labor at their disposal, the Nazis believed the path to ultimate victory was to out-build and out-engineer their enemies. To them, bigger definitely meant better, and better meant more lethal. As Hitler's grip on Europe tightened, he ordered men like Wernher von Braun, Ferdinand Porsche and Alfred Krupp to build increasingly out-

landish machines and structures to realize his master plan. This is World War II told from a new perspective. This series uncovers the engineering secrets of three iconic mega structures, tells the stories of the evil geniuses that designed them and reveals how these structures sparked a technological revolution that changed warfare forever.

## July 17 Atlantic Wall

To protect occupied Europe from an Allied invasion, Hitler demanded the construction of a defensive wall stretching thou-

sands of miles from France in the South to Norway in the North. This is the story of how this vast engineering project sucked in huge quantities of raw materials and men from all over the Third Reich...and faced its ultimate test on D-Day.

## July 24 U-Boat Pens

To create a safe haven in port for their lethal U-boat submarines, the Nazis built massive, impenetrable concrete submarine pens. Structures too immense to be hidden, they were constructed to withstand direct hits from even the biggest Allied bombs. Such was their size and strength that these pens still survive today, a testament to their engineering.

## July 31 V2 Rocket and Dome

The first ever long-range rockets were designed and built by the Nazis in a network of top secret research labs, underground silos and hi-tech launch pads. This is the story of how scientist Werner von Braun heralded the birth of ballistic missiles and laid the technological foundations for the space race.

**A**ntiques Roadshow has visited many cities and has discovered some amazing finds. But through the years, some of the prices of these items have increased dramatically while others have lost value. Join us as we revisit some of these incredible pieces for a fascinating look at their present worth.

## July 1 Vintage Milwaukee

It's been fifteen years since we visited Milwaukee. Ever wonder what some of the items appraised back then are worth now? For example – a Tiffany lamp, which was appraised at \$8,000-\$15,000 in 1998 and is now valued between \$20,000 and \$30,000!

## July 8 Vintage Rochester

Back in 1998, we traveled to Rochester, New York, and appraised items including a painting by Frank Zappa, a van Munster violin and a Minton vase. One of these items increased more than five times in value and another has dropped by more than \$1,000.

## July 15 Vintage Louisville

In 1998, a 19th-century folk art jug was appraised at \$30,000 to \$50,000; it has since leaped in value to an estimated \$100,000 to \$150,000! Tune in for more updates on items like a South Carolina Slave Badge from 1810 and James Dean's high school yearbook.

## July 22 Vintage Hartford

We also visited Hartford in 1998. The big winner here is a Tiffany aquamarine glass vase, which was originally appraised at \$30,000 to \$40,000 and is now valued between \$90,000 and \$100,000.

## July 29 Vintage Richmond

Since 1998, a Cartier desk clock has increased in value, while a Royal Doulton bear has dropped nearly in half. Other items featured include 1956 World Series baseballs, a Carnegie autograph album and a collection of diamond and ruby jewelry.

# Last Will and Testaments

**A**lthough a living trust is the estate planning and testamentary vehicle of choice for most people in Southern Nevada, for those who have modest size estates – such as where there is no real estate involved, and where the only assets are small bank accounts, home furnishings and heirlooms – a will may be the better choice.

A will is important, at a minimum, to designate the individual one would like to serve as executor of his or her estate, to divide the estate among the proper individuals and charities, to declare one's heirs and make any desired disinheritances, and to leave cherished heirlooms and other personal effects to those persons who will most appreciate them.

A will is also used to designate how one's remains are to be handled, and to make wishes known concerning burial, cremation and funeral plans. Many people also take

the opportunity in their last will and testament to nominate a guardian for minor children, if any, and for themselves if necessary. A few definitions and basic requirements for a will in the State of Nevada are as follows:

- The testator (person making the will) must be of sound mind and at least 18 years old. (NRS 133.020)
- Formal wills, as opposed to holographic wills, must be in writing and signed by the testator, and attested to by at least two competent witnesses, subscribing their names to the will in the presence of the testator. NRS 133.040. Notarizing the witnesses' affidavits can be helpful in establishing that the witnesses truly witnessed the execution of the will. (NRS 133.050)
- A holographic will is one in which the signature, date, and material provisions are written by the hand of the testator, whether witnessed or notarized. (NRS 133.090)
- Tangible personal property can be dis-

posed of by a written statement of list left by the testator, so long as the list or statement is referenced in the will. It must also be signed, and dated, as well as be sufficiently clear in identifying the specific personal property and individuals who should respectively take such personal property. Real property and other property with titles, such as bank accounts or corporate stock, should not be included on the list, but rather handled within the body of the will. (NRS 133.045)

## American Masters: A Letter to Elia

**E**lia Kazan is primarily remembered for his impressive directorial body of work in the 1950s – *On the Waterfront*, *East of Eden*, *A Streetcar Named Desire*, *Gentleman's Agreement*, *A Face in the Crowd* – but remained controversial. To many, he was singularly and permanently emblematic of the sin of “naming names” before the House Committee on Un-American Activities. To others, his extraordinary work deserved recognition. One of his strongest supporters was the filmmaker Martin Scorsese, the director of this documentary. A personal and poignant meditation on art and the creative impulse, this is biography and autobiography – Kazan's life, his sense of himself as an immigrant, as an outsider – and Scorsese's early experiences seeing Kazan's films for the first time and being forever influenced.

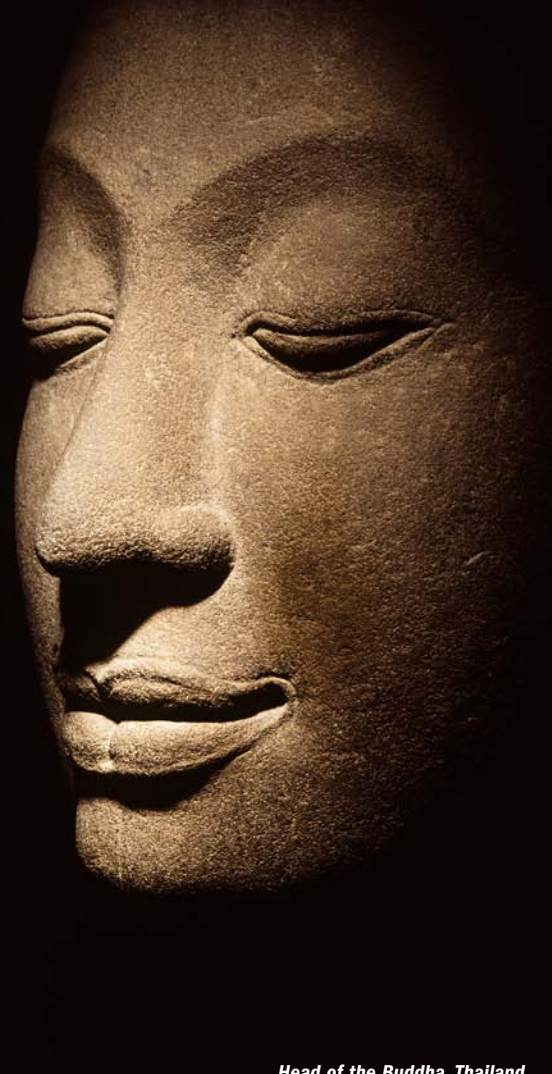

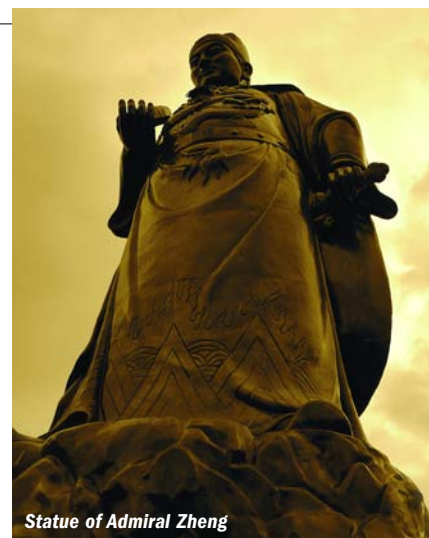

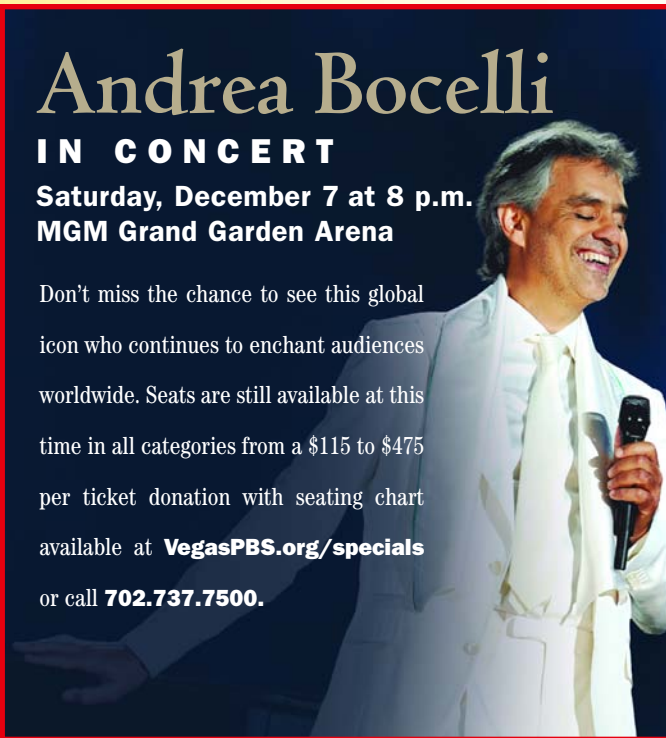
