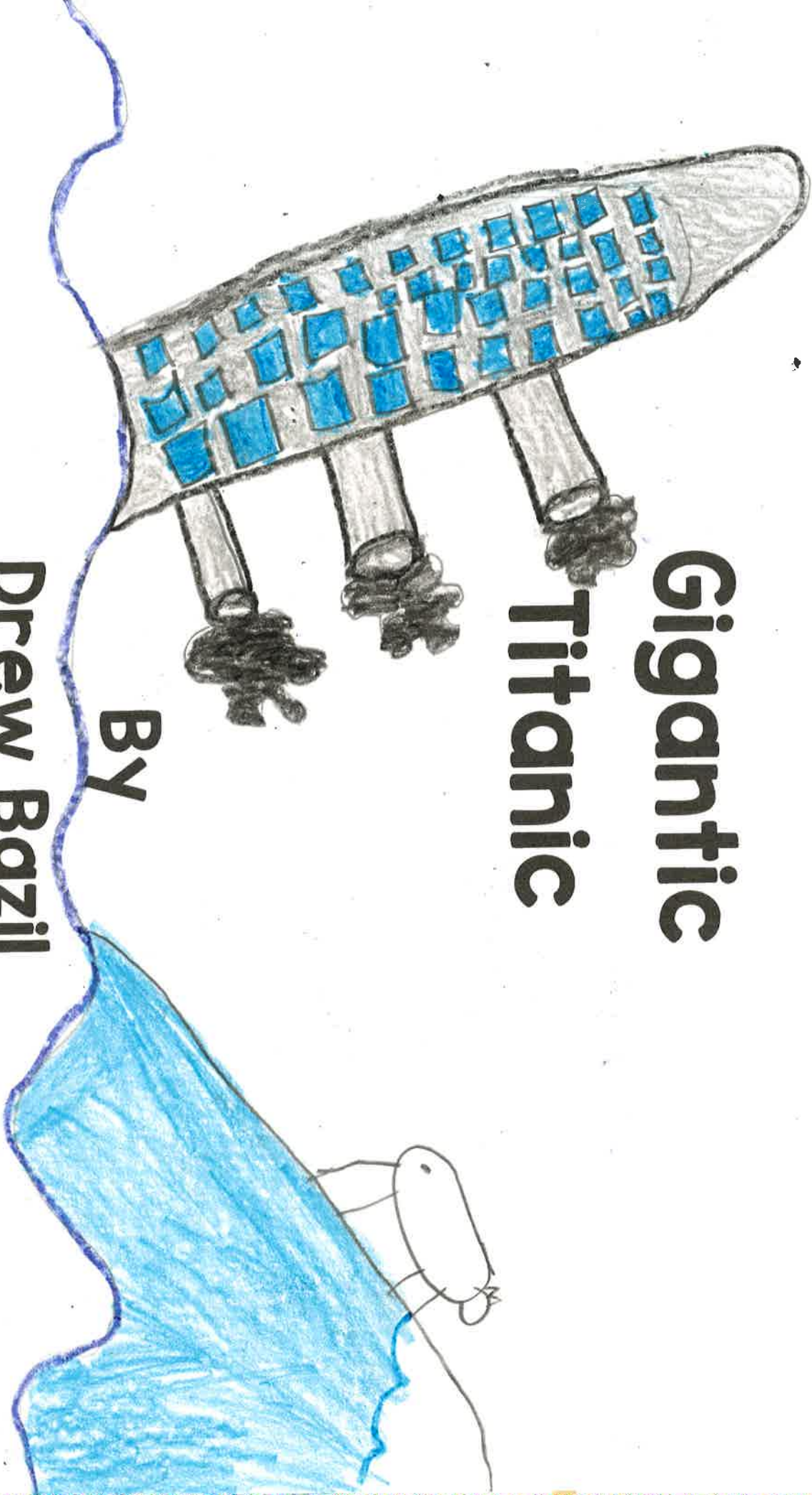


# Gigantic Titanic

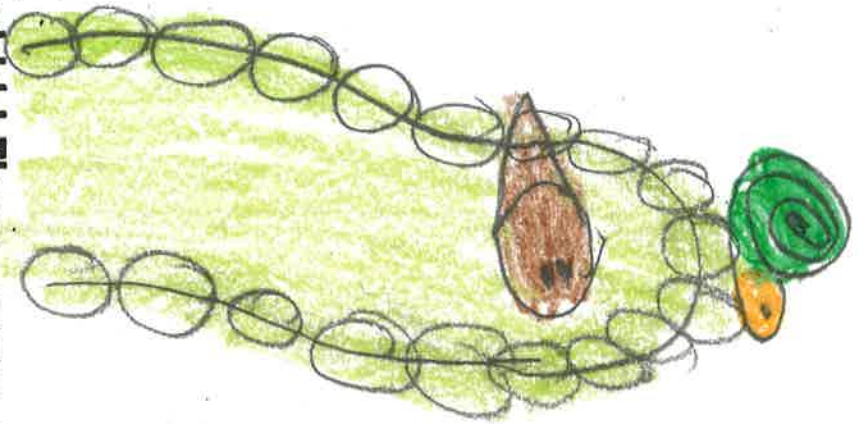

**Facts About the Titanic:**

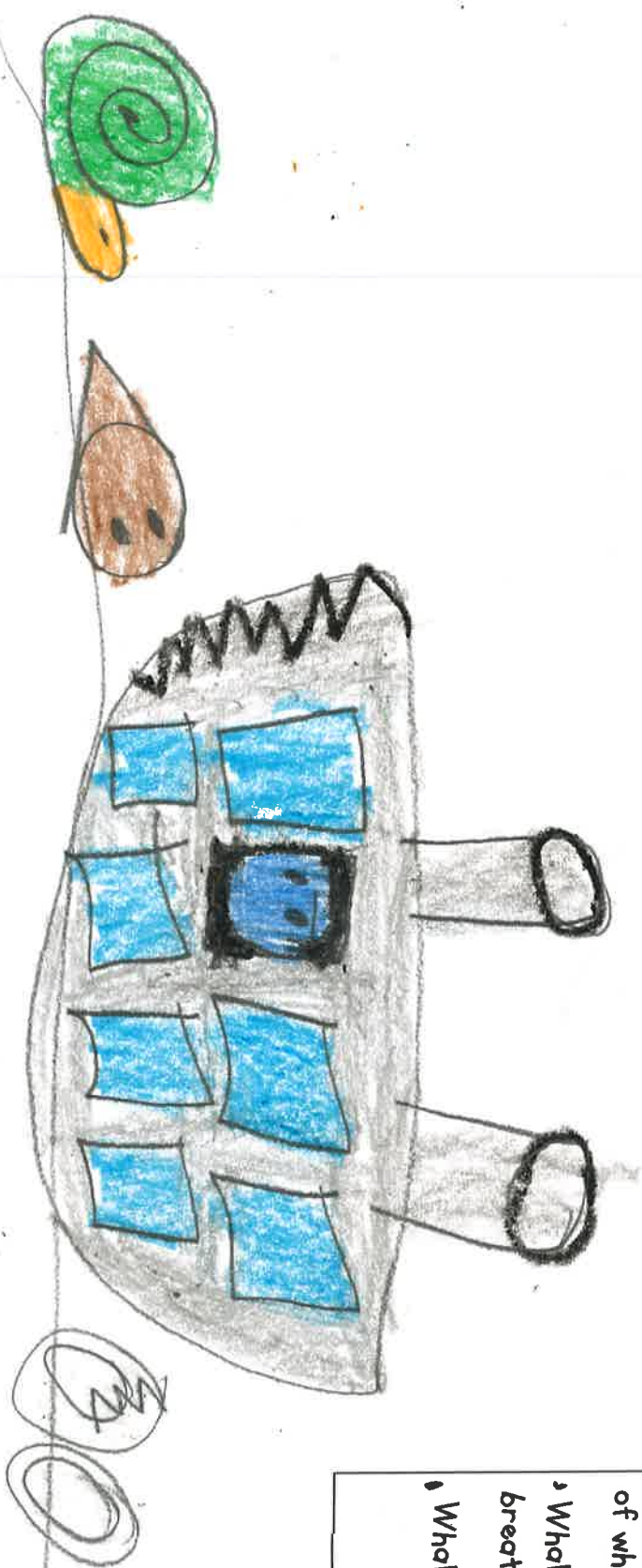
- On April 15<sup>th</sup>, 1912 it hit an iceberg and sank

### Facts About Horseshoe

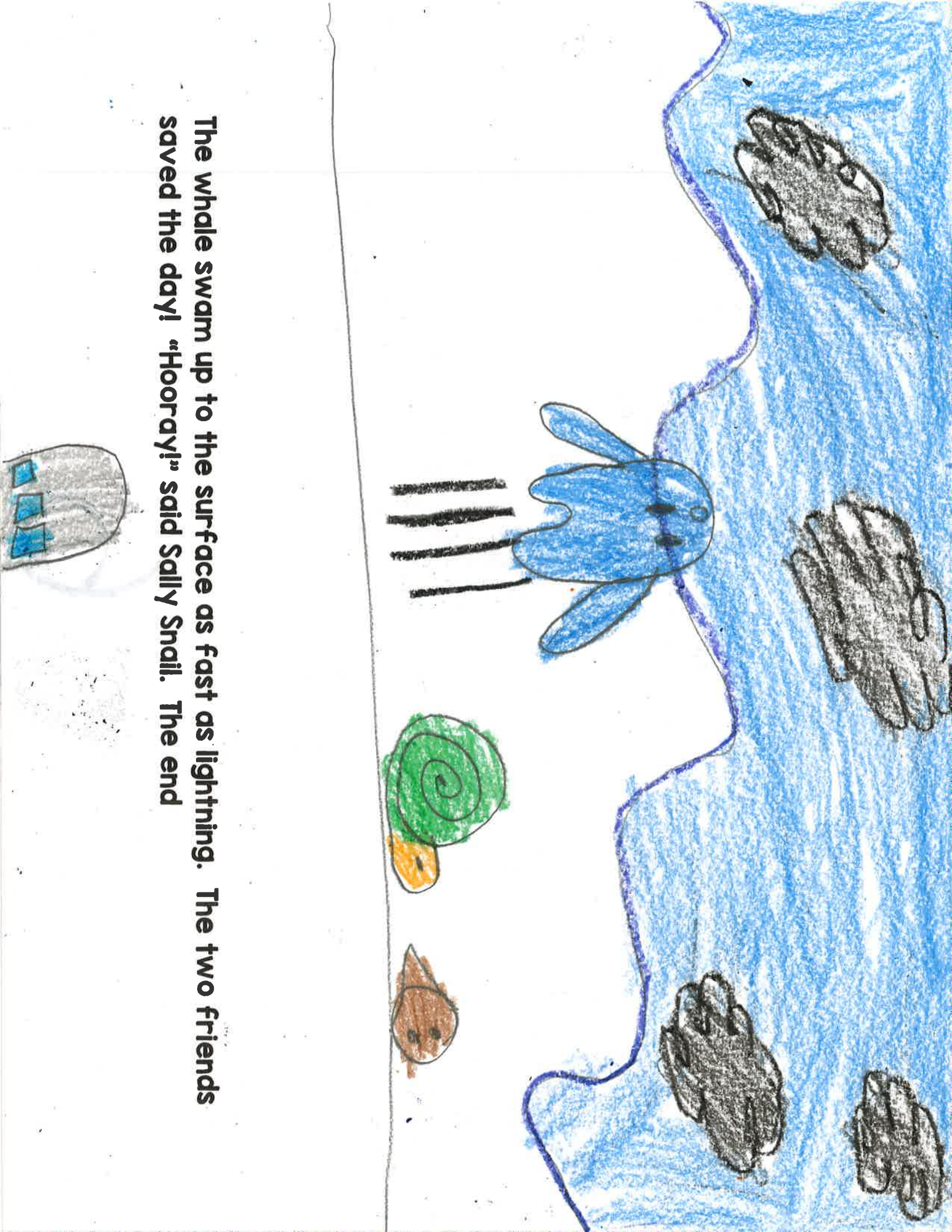
#### Crabs:
