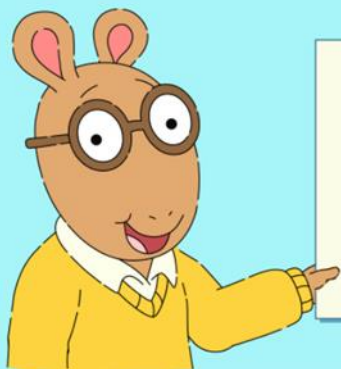
Greetings from Empee Bee!

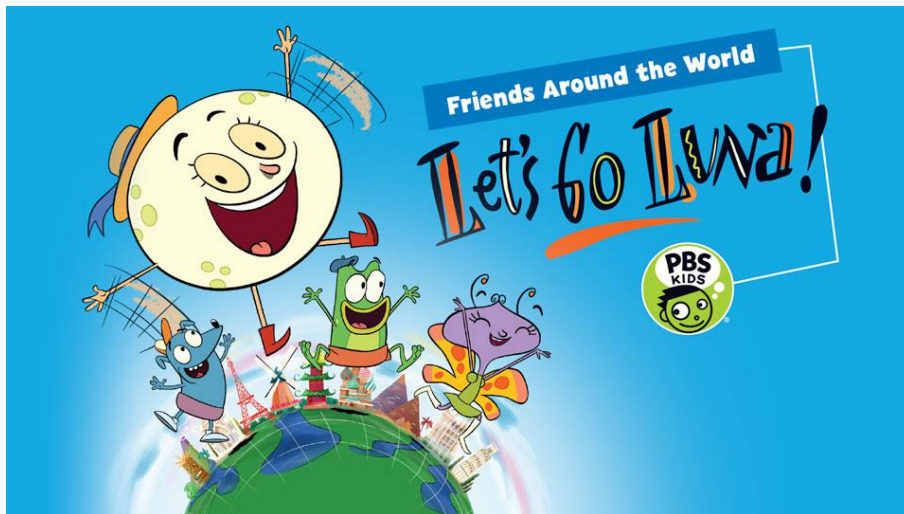
