Issue	Program	Date	Time	Duration	Type/Description
Air Pollution/Health	Healthy Air: Healthy Communities 115	4/17/14	7:00pm	30 minutes	These episode focused on school programs that promote health by increasing walking-whether it's walking to school, or more physical education in schools. The program made the connection between more walking and less driving being healthier for both the environment and our personal health.
Art/Dance	An Evansville Ballet: The Little Mermaid	5/8/14	7:00pm	60 minutes	This special featured the Evansville Youth Philharmonic and Youth Ballet in the production of The Little Mermaid.
Air Pollution/Health	Healthy Air: Healthy Communities 116	5/22/14	7:00pm	30 minutes	This episode focused on vacations that use alternative methods of travel, and overview of the upcoming ozone season and what each alert level means. Highlighted were vacations to areas that provide a variety of public transportation, biking, and walking paths. Local travelers and agents discussed their experience with these particular vacations.
Veteran Issues	Carry Forward: Tri-State Vets Back Home	5/12/14	12:30am	30 minutes	This special featured various local veterans as they described the trials and hardships they faced upon their return from service and how they utilized local service to aid in the reintegration.
Air Pollution/Health	Healthy Air: Healthy Communities 117	6/26/14	7:00pm	30 minutes	This episode focused on how buying local products can save on transportation costs. Savings and less transportation in the areas of the consumer shopping and the product itself being shipped. Local buyers and sellers were interviewed.
History	WNIN's Top 9 101 Weather Disasters	6/12/14	8:30pm	30 minutes	This episode looked at the history of major weather disasters in the Tri-State area including major floods, recent and past tornadoes, and winter storms. Local meteorologists and witnesses described the worst weather events in the Tri-State's history.
History	WNIN's Top 9 103 Infamous Crimes	6/26/14	8:30pm	30 minutes	This episode looked at the worst crimes in the Tri-State's history including murders. Local historians, authors, and crime investigators discuss the nine worst crimes in the Evansville area.
Education	Regional Voices	5/25/14	10:00am	60 minutes	This program featured EVSC Superintendent David Smith's recent State of the Schools address to the local Rotary Club.
