There follows a listing of some of the significant issues responded to by WNIN-TV, Evansville, IN, along with the most significant programming treatment of those issues for the period 7/1/15 – 9/30/15. This listing is by no means exhaustive. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect any priority or significance.

Issue	Program	Date	Time	Duration	Type/Description
Sports/History	WNIN's Top Nine #203	7/2/15	8:00pm	30 minutes	This locally-produced episode featured the top nine high school football coaches in Evansville's history. The list was created by a panel of community reps and the program highlighted each one's accomplishments through interviews and archival photos.
History	Picture This	7/30/15	8:30pm	30 minutes	This local series highlighted at photos taken during specific times in history. This episode focused on Main Street and the Riverfront including the 1938 flood, parades, etc. Local historians discussed the events highlighted in each photo, who took the photo, and the interesting facts hidden within each picture.
Infrastructure	Clear Path: A Community Conversation for Property Owners	7/5/15	6:00pm	60 minutes	This repeat of a live forum feature local representatives from the Evansville Sewer and Water Department explaining how the state-mandated sewer inspection may impact property owner who have blocked easement access. Viewers interacted with the experts to get questions answered.
Veteran Issues	Carry Forward: Tri-State Vets Back Home	7/31/15	4:30am	30 minutes	This special featured various local veterans as they described the trials and hardships they faced upon their return from service and how they utilized local service to aid in the reintegration.
Community	New Vision: New Harmony	8/11/15	7:00pm	60 minutes	This documentary focused on the town of New Harmony and its many distinct attributes. A brief look at its history and interviews with current residents enable the viewer to understand the power and attraction this artistic community has over visitors and residents.
Community	Holiday World: The Koch's Recipe for Success	8/20/15	8:00pm	60 minutes	This documentary examined one of the oldest theme parks in the country, Holiday World. From its creation, by the Koch Family, to the modern day park it is today, the viewer experienced the planning that was and is required to keep the park alive.
Health	Regional Voices: Flora Arzanipour on Acupuncture	9/23/15	10pm	60 minutes	This special featured local acupuncturist Flora Arzanipour, as she explained the many benefits of acupuncture.
Politics	Regional Voices: Robert Dion, UE Professor, on local politics	8/31/15	10pm	30 minutes	Local expert, Professor Robert Dion, spoke about local politics and candidate in front of the Evansville Rotary Club.
