

**9.1 WNIN-TV Program/Topic Report

There follows a listing of some of the significant issues responded to by WNIN-TV, Evansville, IN, along with the most significant programming treatment of those issues for the period 10/1/15 – 12/31/15. This listing is by no means exhaustive. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect any priority or significance.

Issue	Program	Date	Time	Duration	Type/Description
Local History	The Field That Bosse Built	10/26/15	8:00pm	60 minutes	This locally-produced documentary focused on the history behind Bosse Field, one of the oldest sports fields in the U.S. It examined the history of the field and the changes and events over the course of its history. Local sports figures and major players in the field's development were featured.
Local History/Culture	New Vision: New Harmony	10/1/15	7:00pm	60 minutes	This locally-produced documentary focused on the history and culture of New Harmony Indiana. Through interviews with local residents, viewers learned about the history of the small town and how it has grown to become the world-class mecca for artists.
Politics/Elections	The 2015 Evansville Mayoral Debate	10/22/15	7:00pm	90 minutes	This live debate featured incumbent republican Mayor Lloyd Winnecke, Democratic Challenger Gail Reicken, and Independent Challenger Steve Wozniak. Candidates were questioned by local media representing the local commercial TV stations and newspaper.
Sports/History	WNIN's Top 9 #203	12/27/15	4:30pm	30 minutes	This locally-produced episode featured the top nine high school football coaches in Evansville's history. The list was created by a panel of community representatives and the program highlighted each one's accomplishments through interviews and archival photos.
Arts/Culture	Regional Voices	11/22/15	10:00am	30 minutes	This taping featured Brian Knicely, the Director of the Evansville Museum speaking about the recent museum expansion and upcoming programs.
History	WNIN's Top 9 #202 Events That Changed Evansville	12/27/15	5:00PM	30 minutes	This episode looked at the top nine major events that shaped Evansville into the metro it is today. Included was a look at race riots, the birth of the University of Southern Indiana and the effects of WWII.
History	WNIN's Top 9 103 Infamous Crimes	12/27/15	3:00pm	30 minutes	This episode looked at the worst crimes in the Tri-State's history including murders. Local historians, authors, and crime investigators discuss the nine worst crimes in the Evansville area.
Education	Regional Voices	10/18/15	10:00am	30 minutes	This taping featured Linda Bennett, President of the University of Southern Indiana speaking about the 50 years history and anniversary of the university and the impact it has had on the community.

In addition to the reported programs, WNIN regularly tapes and airs various speakers and presentations that have a local interest. During the 4th quarter of 2015, WNIN provided the following content on 9-1: Tom Morrison from the IU Medical Center speaking about the upcoming school that will be located in Evansville and the impact it will have on the community, and Denise Johnson, Director of the Evansville Parks Department speaking about recent upgrades and future plans for local parks and pools.
