Issue	Program	Date	Time	Duration	Type/Description
Driving Safety	Life in the Safe Lane	10/16/16	8:00am	30 minutes	This local half hour examines the many areas that can cause problems while driving. Distractions, Age, Health—and what to do in circumstances such as accidents and incidents.
Politics	Election 2016 Indiana House, County Council, and County Commissioner Candidates	10/10/16	8:00pm	60 minutes	This locally-produced program featured all local candidates for the offices of State House, Vanderburgh County Commission, and Vanderburgh County Council as each candidate spoke for an allotted time about their plans if elected.
Poverty/Politics	Old Dreams, New Ideas	10/6/16	7:00pm	30 minutes	This local program looked at the question of "Is the American Dream still alive". Through interviews with local experts, the program delved into the whether our community still believe in the old American dream of a house, family, and steady income, or if that dream has changed. The program talked with all races, creeds, nationalities, and age groups to discover the American dream is still alive, but not easy to achieve.
Industry/Education	Career Pathways: Taking the Technical Lane	10/6/16	7:30pm	30 minutes	This local program examined our regions need for educated, qualified personnel to work in the many factories and industries in our region. It talked with educators and manufacturers about the possibilities for students following the technical lane and found out that good-paying jobs and good benefits are available to those willing the take that path.
Local History	Evansville At War	12/7/16 and 12/8/16	7:00pm and 8:00pm	60 minutes each	This two-part documentary told the story of Evansville's efforts and importance during WWII through interviews with the people who experienced it.
Local History	Picture This Main Street and the Riverfront	12/29/16	7:00pm	30 minutes	This local program utilized archival photos and a panel of local experts to look at and experience Evansville's Main Street and Riverfront during the 30's, 40's, 50's, and 60's.
Community	Live Local in Warrick County	11/17/16	7:00pm	30 minutes	This local program featured the many events related to agri-business in Warrick County. Local farms, farmers markets, vendors, and events provided an in-depth look at life in Warrick County, Indiana.
Local History	WNIN's Top 9 Weather Disasters	12/28/16	10:30pm	30 minutes	This local program featured archival photos and a panel of experts to explain the area's major weather events over the past 100 years. Events included several tornadoes, the great flood of 1937, and the winter the river froze.
