Issue	Program	Date	Time	Duration	Type/Description
Weather	Day of Darkness	8/17/17 and 8/18/17	8:00pm, 8:30pm 9:30pm	30 minutes	This locally-produced special focused on the upcoming solar eclipse by featuring local meteorologists and experts explaining the science behind the eclipse and how to be best prepared for viewing it.
Culture/Travel	Tri-State Life	8/24/17	10:00am	30 minutes	This local program featured local artisans and their crafts. From a yarn weaver, to a birdhouse creator, viewers get a taste of the local flavor that our region presents
Local Arts	The University of Evansville Theatre	9/14/17	7:00pm	30 minutes	This special looked at the history of the University of Evansville's theatre department as told by those who participated in its long and regal history.
Community	Live Local in Warrick County	7/23/17	10:30pm	30 minutes	This program featured the activities that make up agri-business and events in Warrick County. Highlights included various Farmers' markets, wineries, farms, etc.
History	Evansville At War	9/7/17	9:00pm	60 minutes	Evansville's great history during WWII is the focus of this local documentary. The Shipyard that create the LSTs to the manufacturing of bullets, Evansville was instrumental to the war effort as the war was to Evansville.
Local Culture	Sunset at Semper Fulgens III	9/7/17	8:00pm	60 minutes	This program highlighted a local concert featuring Matthew O'Neill and Darrell Scott. The program was performed and recorded at an downtown Evansville residence known as Semper Fulgens.
History	WNIN's Top 9	7/27/17	7:00pm	30 minutes	This local episode focused on Evansville's historic buildings between the 30's and 60's.
History	The Field That Bosse Built	8/31/17	7:00pm	60 minutes	This documentary told the story of local baseball field, Bosse Field. The second oldest ball park in the nation, the program featured testimonials from many local residents and enthusiasts including field owner.
