Issue	Program	Date	Time	Duration	Type/Description
<b>Local Business</b>	JA Hall of Fame 2018	4/2/18	9:00pm	60 minutes	Recorded at the 2018 Junior Achievement Hall of Fame presentation, this special highlighted three iconic business people who had a profound impact on the local community. Viewers learned about their history and what they have done to better the community as a whole.
<b>Education</b>	Indiana State of High Education	4/10/18	10:30pm	30 minutes	This program featured the 2018 Indiana State of High Education report that was presented live on 4/9/19.
<b>Education</b>	EVSC Community Link	4/14/18	5:00pm	30 minutes	This monthly program highlights local non-profits and is produced by the students of Bosse High School.
<b>Arts in Education</b>	Shorts by HighSchoolers	4/19/19	7:00pm	60 minutes	This annual program features films by local High School teams and a panel of judges who review the finalists and provide feedback. The winning team is presented with local college scholarships.
<b>History</b>	Two Elephants	6/5/18	7:00pm	60 minutes	This locally-produced documentary looked at the history of Elephants at the Evansville Zoo. The story started with Kay the Elephant and the impact she had on the community and ended with a look at Bunny the Elephants life at the zoo and her tragic death.
<b>Education</b>	2018 State of the Schools	5/13/18	10:00am	60 minutes	Presented by School Superintendent Dr. David Smith, this report focused on the successes and challenges of the Evansville Vanderburgh School Corporation.
<b>History</b>	Evansville Remembers the Vietnam War	4/30/18	12:00am	30 minutes	This special featured local Vietnam Vets as they told their war-time stories including how the war affected them, the world, and the Evansville area.
<b>Community</b>	New Vision New Harmony	5/10/18	7:00pm	60 minutes	This local documentary looked the utopian community of New Harmony Indiana. After a brief history, viewers learned about the many attractions and events.
<b>Education</b>	Indiana Geography Bee	6/13/18	12:30pm	30 minutes	This annual program highlights the annual event and winner.

In addition to the reported programs, WNIN regularly tapes and airs various speakers and presentations that have a local interest.
