This listing is by no means exhaustive. The order in which the issues appear does not reflect any priority or significance.

Issue	Program	Date	Time	Duration	Type/Description
<b>Armed Services</b>	Five Days With The Marines	10/18/18	7:00pm	30 minutes	This local documentary followed a "Marine Mom" April Mitchell on a five day stay at Marine's training boot camp. Mitchell a mother of two Marine sons gives a first-hand account of the type of rigors encounters by the recruits.
<b>Local Politics</b>	Election Special 2018	10/22/18	7:00pm	60 minutes	This live local special featured debates between candidates for Vanderburgh County Prosecutor, County Commission, and Indiana State Rep. Hosted by WNIN's John Gibson, candidates were asked questions of a panel representing various media organizations.
<b>Education</b>	EVSC Community Link	10/27/18	5:00pm	30 minutes	This monthly program highlights local non-profits and is produced by the students of Bosse High School.
<b>Senior Abuse</b>	Senior Fraud: Financial Safety for Seniors	11/15/18	7:00pm	60 minutes	This local production featured local and State experts in the issue of financial fraud, focusing on senior citizens. Viewers learned about the various types of scams, how to handle them, and where to get help.
<b>History</b>	The Big Beer Doc	11/27/18	7:00pm	60 minutes	This local production examined the history of local breweries over the past century. Evansville was home to many breweries that had a major impact of the local economy.
<b>War History</b>	Chester & Gertrude At War	11/29/18	7:00pm	60 minutes	This local production highlighted the life of one local gentleman's trip overseas to serve in WWI. Chester's relatives traveled to France with WNIN's crew to see where Chester was killed in service and to see his name added to a local war monument.
<b>History</b>	Evansville Remembers the Vietnam War	10/18/18	7:30pm	30 minutes	This special featured local Vietnam Vets as they told their war-time stories including how the war affected them, the world, and the Evansville area.
<b>History</b>	WNIN's Top 9 Historic Buildings in Downtown	10/11/18	7:00pm	30 minutes	This local documentary focused on the many famous buildings and establishments that made Downtown Evansville their home over the past 100 years.
<b>History</b>	Picture This Historic Homes and School Buildings	12/6/18	7:00pm	30 minutes	This local documentary looked at historic homes and schools through a collection of historical photographs and postcards.
