H1N1 Virus	H1N1: A WNI Forum	9-1: 10/29/09	7:30pm	30 minutes	This live forum featured local experts in the fields of health and education to discuss the possible effects of the recent H1N1 pandemic, answer viewer questions about the health threat and offer advice and tips for preventing the spread of the flu.

Children's reading skills	Napoleon Peacock's Adventure Around Town	9-1: 10/4/09	6:30am	30 minutes	This locally-produced episode uses a peacock to help children learn to read. Each story has been written by a local author.
Local History	LST-325: History on the Riverfront	9-1: 12/10/09	7:00pm	30 minutes	This locally-produced documentary featured a tour of the local LST-325 ship and focused on it's history in Evansville and the life of many local veterans.
Arts and Culture	Sounds of the Season	9-1: 12/25/09	8:00am, 11:00am, and 4:00pm	60 minutes	This locally-produced concert featured local students as they sang a variety of both traditional and non-traditional Christmas music.
Local History	Feel The History	9-1: 12/19/09	5:00pm	30 minutes	This magazine style program was produced by the students as Reitz High School and featured an in-depth look at the history behind Abraham Lincoln's childhood in the Tri-State
